JAMES'S STORY

James stepped into serving at Summer VBS at Campbell County without much experience in kids ministry, but God used it to shape him in unexpected ways. Watching the children engage in worship and Bible lessons was striking. "They were joyful, open, and completely uninhibited," James shared. "They simply received what was being taught with trust and excitement."

That experience brought Matthew 11:25 to mind, reminding him that God is not looking for sophistication, but for "hearts that are humble, receptive, and willing to receive."



Through this simple step of obedience, James discovered what he calls "a quiet, spiritual joy" on the other side of serving, a reminder that God has prepared good works for us to walk in, and joy to meet us there.



ALLEE & ANA'S STORY

Allee and Ana are graduating high school seniors who serve together as K and 1st grade leaders in fc|Kids Elementary at the Burlington Campus. They have been faithfully serving for years, quietly showing up each week with consistency, care, and a genuine love for the kids in their class.

Though they would never seek the spotlight, their impact is often seen behind the scenes through the meaningful relationships they build each week.

Ana shared that serving has shaped her in unexpected ways. "I believe through serving God has taught me to enjoy the small things," she said. "Kids find joy in little things, and everything is a story. Being excited about small things has made me happier."

Their joy in serving is contagious, and their faithfulness is a powerful reminder that God is raising up young leaders who are making a real difference through simple presence, commitment, and love.

UNION CONSTRUCTION

2025 marked a pivotal year in the story of our future Union Campus. What began as vision and prayer moved steadily into action, as each month brought tangible progress toward a space that will serve families, neighbors, and generations to come.

In July, we celebrated a significant milestone with a groundbreaking ceremony, marking the official start of the project. Excavation followed in August as the site began to take physical shape.

By October, building plans were approved by Boone County, and November brought several critical steps, including the signing of the sales contract on our current building and the closing of the construction loan.

As the year came to a close, work continued with the final grading of the building footprint and future soccer field in December, followed by the start of footer construction. Momentum continued into the new year with the closing of the out lot in front of the current campus, helping further support the Union Campus project.

Each milestone represents more than construction progress. It reflects the generosity, prayers, and shared commitment of our church family to create a place where people can encounter Jesus, find community, and take their next step of faith. Our best days truly are ahead.
