WHY STUDENTS MATTER

at a glance

- 21,829 students go to a public middle or high school in Boone, Kenton and Campbell County (2025)
- 22% of Gen Z self-identify as Christian and have made a personal commitment to follow Jesus Christ.
- 48% of Gen Z are not Christian and hold some other belief about who Jesus is.
- 70% of students walk away from the church and their faith between the ages of 18–22.

STRATEGY FOR STUDENTS

Connecting students to someone who loves God and loves them, so they can develop an authentic faith (Relational Engagement).

Helping students become lifelong Jesus followers through growing DEEPER - Deeper in their Biblical Knowledge and Deeper through Spiritual Practices (discipling and leadership development).

These two concepts are weaved through everything in Student Ministry.



WHAT WE DO

According to research, students are wrestling with 3 big questions*:

- Who am I?
- Where do I fit in?
- What difference can I make?

These questions are rooted in a search for identity, belonging, and purpose. As students search for answers to these questions, we can point them to Jesus. As a ministry, we aim to answer these questions about identity, belonging, and purpose by connecting them to Jesus, community, and serving. Through these three areas of connection, we work to remove unnecessary barriers so students can go deeper as a follower of Jesus.

To better understand how we work to do this, let's look at our three channels. Through prayer and the work of the Holy Spirit, the three channels used to accomplish the mission of FC's Students are Student Experiences, Groups, and Making a Difference.

3 CHANNELS

Student Experiences

- Sunday Gatherings and weekly gatherings like CONNECT are key to building lifelong faith.
 Sunday Gatherings provide intergenerational worship and help students connect with the broader church community. CONNECT offers a fun, welcoming space for games, devotionals, and small groups. A few times a year, all campuses come together for Student Nights—events focused on worship and helping students take next steps in faith.
- Events like CIY MIX, CIY MOVE, and Fall Retreats give students a chance to deepen their faith, build friendships, and invite others into the journey of following Jesus.

CONNECT

CONNECT is our weekly student gathering on Sunday nights from 5:30–7:00 PM (September through May) at each campus. It's a low-stakes, fun environment where students can bring friends, enjoy games and hang time, and participate in a short devotional and small group discussion. We CONNECT students to Jesus and each other.

STUDENT NIGHTS

These are large, student-focused events hosted a few times each year at the Burlington campus. They're designed to inspire students to look beyond themselves, explore their faith, and connect to Jesus and His Kingdom. Student Nights also provide an entry point to join groups, start serving, and engage with our Kingdom Workers leadership team.

SUMMER CAMP

CIY MIX (for middle school students) and CIY MOVE (for high school students) are weeklong summer experiences focused on helping students encounter Jesus and live for His Kingdom. These trips are pivotal moments in a student's discipleship journey.

Groups

- **Groups** meet Sunday mornings at each campus and are divided by age and gender. In these environments, students build Biblical knowledge, ask honest questions, and form trusted relationships with adult leaders and peers. Before groups begin, students connect through hangout time and games, followed by a message from a student leader.
- Groups create space for students to belong, be real, and grow in their faith.

GROUPS/SUNDAY MORNINGS

Groups are all about relationships and spiritual growth. Students come to connect with their tribe, dive into Scripture, and ask questions in a safe space. These gatherings build community and deepen their walk with Jesus.

SUMMER CAMP

CIY MIX (for middle school) and CIY MOVE (for high school) are week-long summer experiences designed to help students encounter Jesus and grow in their faith—together. These trips are powerful opportunities for small groups to bond deeply, share spiritual milestones, and take meaningful steps in their discipleship journey as a community.

 our Kingdom Workers student leadership team.
