Responsibilities:

- Greet students and guests with a friendly smile.
 - Assist with the check-in process and guide first-time guests.
 - Hang out with first-time guests to ensure they feel comfortable and connected.
 - Serve food and drinks, ensuring everyone is taken care of.
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TEACHING TEAM

If you have a gift or passion for communicating God's Word, this team is for you. You'll help prepare and teach lessons, using creative and fresh approaches to communicate each topic and help others grow in their relationship with God.
