# OUR STORY

THE STORY OF VALLEY VIEW CHRISTIAN CHURCH IS A STORY OF GOD LEADING AND HIS PEOPLE FOLLOWING. IT BEGINS IN 1957, WHEN A SMALL GROUP OF FAMILIES PLANTED LITTLETON CHRISTIAN CHURCH WITH A CLEAR CONVICTION: GOD'S WORD WOULD DIRECT THEIR PATH, AND JESUS WOULD BE THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING THEY BUILT.



In 1958, the church broke ground on its first building. It was a bold step – ordinary people staking their future on the belief that God was calling them to create a place where lives would be shaped by the gospel for generations to come.

Through the mid-1980s, God continued to move. As more people encountered Christ and found community, the church grew and expanded into additional facilities. Every square foot became another opportunity to lead people toward the full and abundant life found only in Jesus. As more people encountered Christ and found community, the church grew and expanded into additional facilities and planted several churches.

By 1994, it became clear that God was steering the church toward a new horizon. Leaders sought His direction, praying for clear guidance. Their prayers led to a decisive moment in 1999 when the church purchased 25 acres at Santa Fe and Titan Road. What looked like open land became a canvas for God's unfolding work.

In 2004, the new campus opened and the church embraced a new name, Valley View Christian Church. With a wider view and a deeper mission, the church pressed forward, committed to being biblically anchored, selflessly serving, radically generous, missionally minded, and intentionally gathering as one body.

After many faithful years of leadership, Pastor Gene Barron prepared to pass the baton. In 2016, the elders entered a season of prayer and discernment, trusting God to reveal the next shepherd. In 2017, the church unanimously confirmed Phillip Holland as Lead Pastor, stepping confidently into the next chapter God had prepared.

From the beginning, God has been writing this story. Our part has simply been to trust Him, follow His lead, and take the next step of faith, again and again.

**As we look to the future, our mission remains unwavering: that you and your family would believe in Jesus, belong in community, and become everything God created you to be.**

This is our story – guided by God, grounded in Scripture, and still unfolding with every step of faith we take.






## NEW WORSHIP CENTER SEATING

## START YOUR PERSONAL "MAKING ROOM" JOURNEY

A good place to start is to know your current giving and your current posture toward giving. Pages 36-41 in this journal will help you begin this journey. Prayerfully ask the Spirit to show you where you are and where He might be calling you to be.



## ASK, "WHAT WOULD GROWTH LOOK LIKE FOR ME?"

As you pray, pay attention to both your heart and specific things the Spirit brings to mind.



## TAKE A STEP OF FAITH WITH A "MAKING ROOM" COMMITMENT

Complete the commitment worksheets on pages 40 and 41 to arrive at your three-year commitment to MAKING ROOM. Make sure you understand the "One Fund. One Mission" approach outlined on page 35. Our church-wide commitment Sunday will be during our normal service times on Sunday, March 8, 2026.



## GIVE AND LIVE GENEROUSLY

For the next three years, live in a way that stretches you and increases your faith in all areas of life: relationally, financially and spiritually.



## SHARE YOUR JOURNEY

Share with others what the Lord is teaching you in this season. Talk about it in your classes, small groups, and casual conversations. Generosity is contagious and encourages others to live by faith in God, who is so generous to us.

# ONE MISSION. ONE FUND.

## WHAT IS A ONE FUND?

In the past, many churches — including ours — have used multiple funds to support ministry. You may have been asked to continue giving to a general fund while also giving an additional gift toward a special project or initiative. God has faithfully used those approaches to move ministry forward, and we're grateful for how He has provided in every season.

As we've prayed and listened for where God is leading Valley View next, we believe He's inviting us into something simpler — and more unified.

At Valley View, everything we do flows from one mission: to lead every generation to a full life in Christ. The truth is, our ministries are deeply connected. The spaces we gather in, the people we serve, the staff who equip and lead, the children and students we invest in, and the way we reach our community and beyond — all of it works together to advance the same mission. Because of that, our elders have chosen to move forward with a One Fund approach.

A One Fund means all generosity at Valley View goes into one shared mission. There isn't a separation between "regular giving" and initiative giving. Every gift — whether it's part of your ongoing generosity or a step of faith toward our MAKING ROOM vision — supports the same purpose: creating space to lead every generation to a full life in Christ.

This approach helps us celebrate generosity as one collective story. It allows us to see the full impact of what God is doing through our church and how every act of giving works together to serve our neighbors, strengthen our ministries, and expand our reach.

The MAKING ROOM initiative will take place over the next three years as we faithfully implement the commitments made today — trusting God to lead, provide, and use our obedience to impact lives for generations to come.

## SEEING BEYOND THE PRESENT

Read Habakkuk 2:2-3. God's vision often feels delayed, but it is never denied. Our impatience can cause us to settle for what's visible instead of believing for what's promised. Write down one thing you're praying for that hasn't yet come to pass – and wait in faith.

## STRETCHING FAITH

Read Isaiah 54:2. Growth requires stretching. Every time we step into new territory, there's tension. That tension isn't punishment, it's preparation. Let today's discomfort remind you that God is expanding your capacity for blessing.

## THE POWER OF PREPARATION

Read Exodus 19:10-11. Before God appeared on Sinai, He told the people to prepare. God still meets those who make room. What habits, schedules, or spaces could you prepare this week for Him to fill?

Read Proverbs 29:18. "Where there is no vision, the people perish." God's vision always reaches beyond one generation. Pray that the vision of Valley View would bless children not yet born and people not yet reached.

## PRAYER FOCUS

Pray for a renewed heart – that God would clear out anything cluttering your love, focus, or obedience to Him. Ask Him to fill you afresh with His Spirit so your heart becomes His dwelling.

2. What distractions or habits might be crowding your heart?
3. How can you intentionally create spiritual space this week – in prayer, margin, or rest?

## THE INVITATION TO PREPARE

Read 2 Kings 4:8-9. The Shunammite woman didn't wait for Elisha to ask; she initiated. God often waits for our invitation. Today, invite Him into your schedule, your decisions, and your home.

## CLEARING THE CLUTTER

Read Psalm 139:23-24. Ask God to search your heart for what's crowding His presence. Clutter in our souls keeps us from clarity in our calling. Confess distractions and refocus on Him.

Read Mark 1:35. Jesus regularly withdrew to lonely places to pray. If He needed intentional solitude, so do we. Block a time today to step away from noise and simply be with God.

Read 2 Kings 4:15-17. The Shunammite woman never expected a child – yet God gave one. Making room creates the environment for miracles. What might God do if you truly made space for Him?
