

CONFIRMATION AT TRINITY KLEIN

The goal of Confirmation at Trinity Klein is for each student to be prepared and equipped to confirm their baptismal faith publicly by the conclusion of the confirmation journey.

Students will attain this goal as they take ownership of their confirmation journey by participating in and completing the following:

- **Launch Meeting**

A large group launch meeting for all students wanting to begin their confirmation journey will be held annually towards the end of August that will explain the confirmation process. Parents and students are required to attend in order to begin.

- **Confirmation Journals & Unit Check-Ins**

Students will each be given a confirmation journal that will consist of approximately ninety lessons broken down into eight units. Students wishing to complete the program in a year should aim to complete each unit in between Confirmation Church services.

We encourage students to share with their parents what they are learning along the way. This is a great opportunity to grow together! At times, the journal will even prompt students to share. What you put into the journey is what you will get out.

Each unit will begin with an opening video from Pastor Lee to introduce the unit and close with a video that will help guide each student's journey. At the conclusion of each unit, students will complete the "Unit Check-In" that will be sent to Pastor Lee, their parents, and a confirmation mentor.

Unit Check-Ins, videos, and other resources for your confirmation journals will be available at confirmation.trinityklein.org.

- **Confirmation Church**

Students will join with their families¹ once a month for what we will call "Confirmation Church" that will take place on eight Sundays throughout the year. Confirmation Church will consist of an hour-long worship service that is experiential, focused on teaching, and that highlights the unit we covered in the journal. After the service, students will have thirty minutes with their confirmation groups. While students join their confirmation groups (led by confirmation mentors), parents will remain with pastor in the large room.

The focus of these services will be the confirmation journey and the Six Chief Parts of the Christian Faith. Confirmation Church will be in session from September to April. To complete the confirmation journey, students will attend all eight services of Confirmation Church.

¹ *Should a student's parents be unable to attend regularly with the student, Trinity Klein will provide a confirmation sponsor for the duration of the student's journey.*

- **Small Group Participation**

Students who wish to complete the confirmation journey must be an active participant in a small group ministry during their time on the journey. Sunday Night Crew Small Groups take place on Sundays from 6-8pm beginning on the second weekend of September and continuing through April. The night begins with food (at no cost) and fellowship, transitions into a time of games and a brief teaching, before transitioning into the best part of the night—time with our small groups!

- **Confirmation Verse and Banner**

As a student nears the end of their confirmation journey, they will select a bible verse (or have one selected for them) that will serve as their confirmation verse. During this time, we will provide materials and instructions for the student to complete a confirmation banner that will be displayed during the confirmation service.

- **Celebration Interview**

Once a student has completed their Confirmation Journal they may set up a Celebration Interview where they will review their confirmation journey and finish their preparation to confirm their baptismal faith publicly. For those beginning the journey in August, interviews will take place in the Spring.

- **What is the cost of the Confirmation program?**

The cost of the program is \$100. This fee includes a catechism, banner supplies, robe rental, and confirmation journals.

- **What if I have younger children at Confirmation Church?**

Every member of the family is welcome to join us at Confirmation Church! Kids in kindergarten to 4th grade are also welcome to join our Kids' Ministry staff at Kids' Worship. While Pastor Lee is talking with parents and confirmation students are with their mentors, we have high school students who will provide childcare until the meetings are wrapped up. Please just let us know if you have children in the nursery or Kids' Worship so our high schoolers can pick them up after worship.

- **What if I didn't join in August?**

Please talk with Courtney Limmer about the next opportunity to begin your confirmation journey.

- **How long do I have to complete the program?**

This program is designed to focus a student's efforts into a one-year journey. That being said, if a student does not complete their journey within two years' time, they will meet with Pastor Lee to discuss restarting the journey.

ADDITIONAL MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS

- **Acolyte Rotation**

All 6th to 12th graders are invited and encouraged to participate as acolytes in our regular worship services. This is a wonderful opportunity to serve alongside God's people in His house. A sign-up will become available for those students who wish to join the acolyte *rotation*. If you have never participate before, we will need to set up a brief training session before you begin signing up.

- **Jr. High Mission to Houston, June 7-10, 2027**

Each summer our outgoing 7th and 8th graders serve in our own backyard on our Jr. High Mission to Houston. We stay at Trinity Downtown and serve the people of the inner loop through various organizations. The cost of attending is \$125.

- **High School Mission Trip to Alabama - July 11-17, 2027**

Current 9th-12th grade students will partner with YouthWorks to serve the resilient community of **Bayou La Batre** through home improvement projects, elder care, and children's ministries.

- **Life's Flight, Date TBD**
