What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Magnified Bookmark" on cardstock and cut, one per child. Write each child's name on their bookmark.

During the Activity: Help children add their fingerprint in the center of the magnifying glass. Clean hands.

What You Say:

During the Activity: "Let's make a bookmark. This is a picture of a magnifying glass. Let's add your wonderful, amazing fingerprint in the middle of your magnifying glass. Press your finger on the inkpad (*help children as needed*), and now press it on your paper. (*Help children press their finger inside the magnifying glass, then help clean their hands.*)

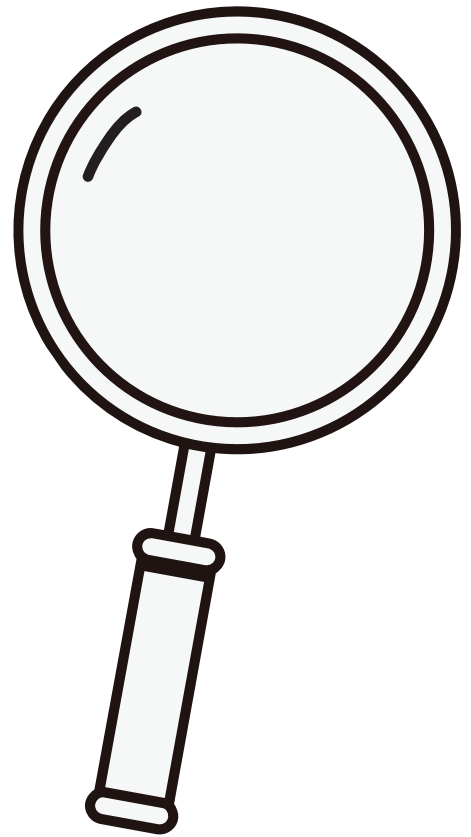
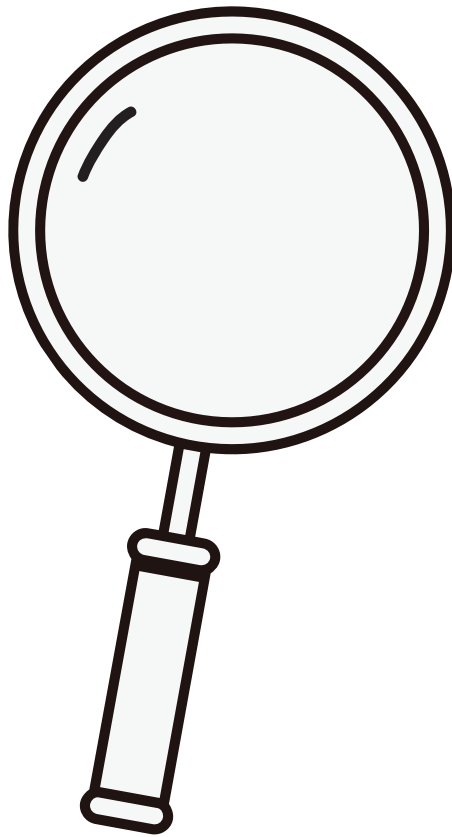
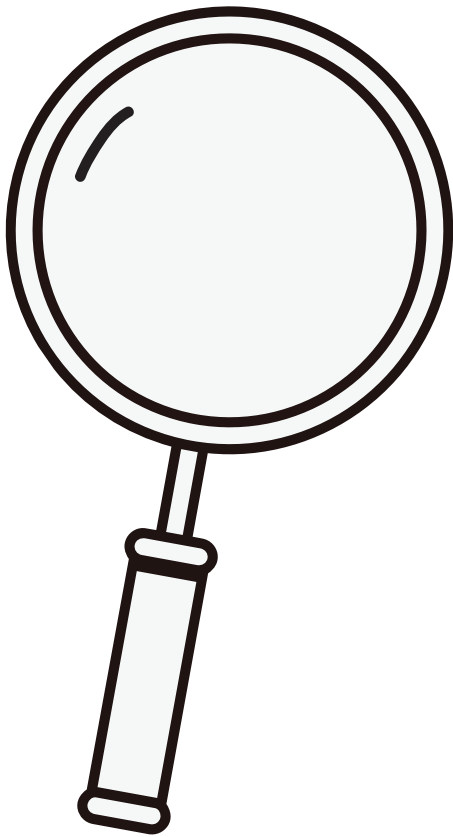

"At first, there was nothing; then God created light. Then God made the land, plants, oceans, and sky. (Hold up this picture.) He made the sun and the fluffy clouds in the day (hold up the picture of the sun and fluffy clouds), and a beautiful moon and twinkling stars at night. (Hold up the picture of the moon and stars.) God made it all, but that's not all. God made animals big and small, like elephants and lions, turtles and grasshoppers too. (Hold up the picture of the animals.) The whole earth is filled with God's creation, and He takes care of it all. But that's still not all God made. God made people! That means God made you! (Hold up the mirror to each child and say ...) [Bottom Line] God made you wonderful."

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Handprint Keepsake Label" on label paper, one label per child. Write each child's name on their plastic bag and place their label on the front. Flatten out a disc of Model Magic about five inches in diameter, one per child.

During the Activity: Help children cover their hand with ink and press down into the Model Magic disc. Clean child's hands and place their handprint in their bag and send home.

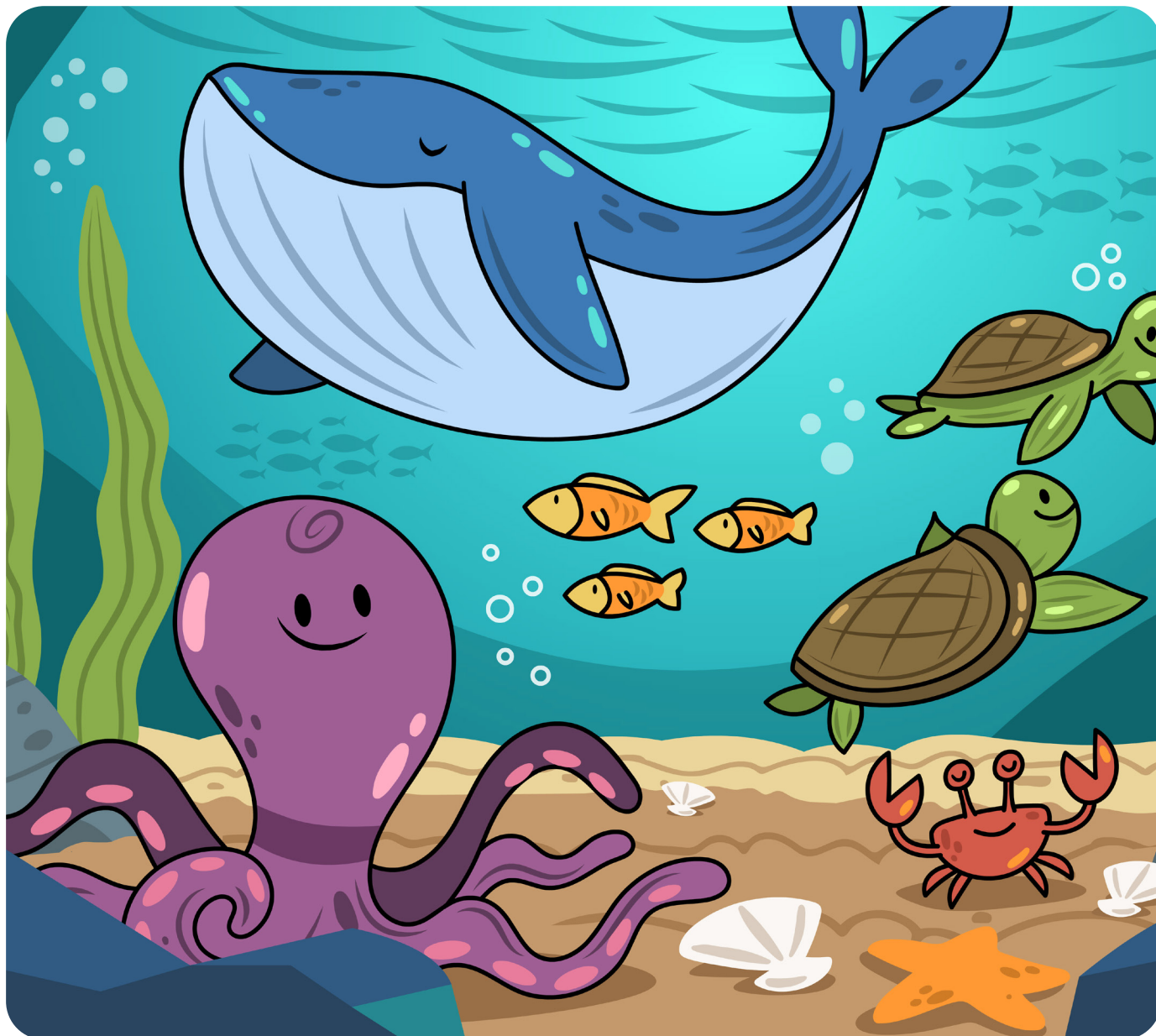
What You Say:

During the Activity: "Today we are going to make a handprint to keep. Let's cover your hand with ink (*help child completely cover their hand with ink*) and press it down on the disc. (*Help guide child's hand straight down and back up.*) Now let's clean your hands. (*Pause.*) Look at your cool handprint! God made you amazing and wonderful! **[Bottom Line] God made you wonderful."**

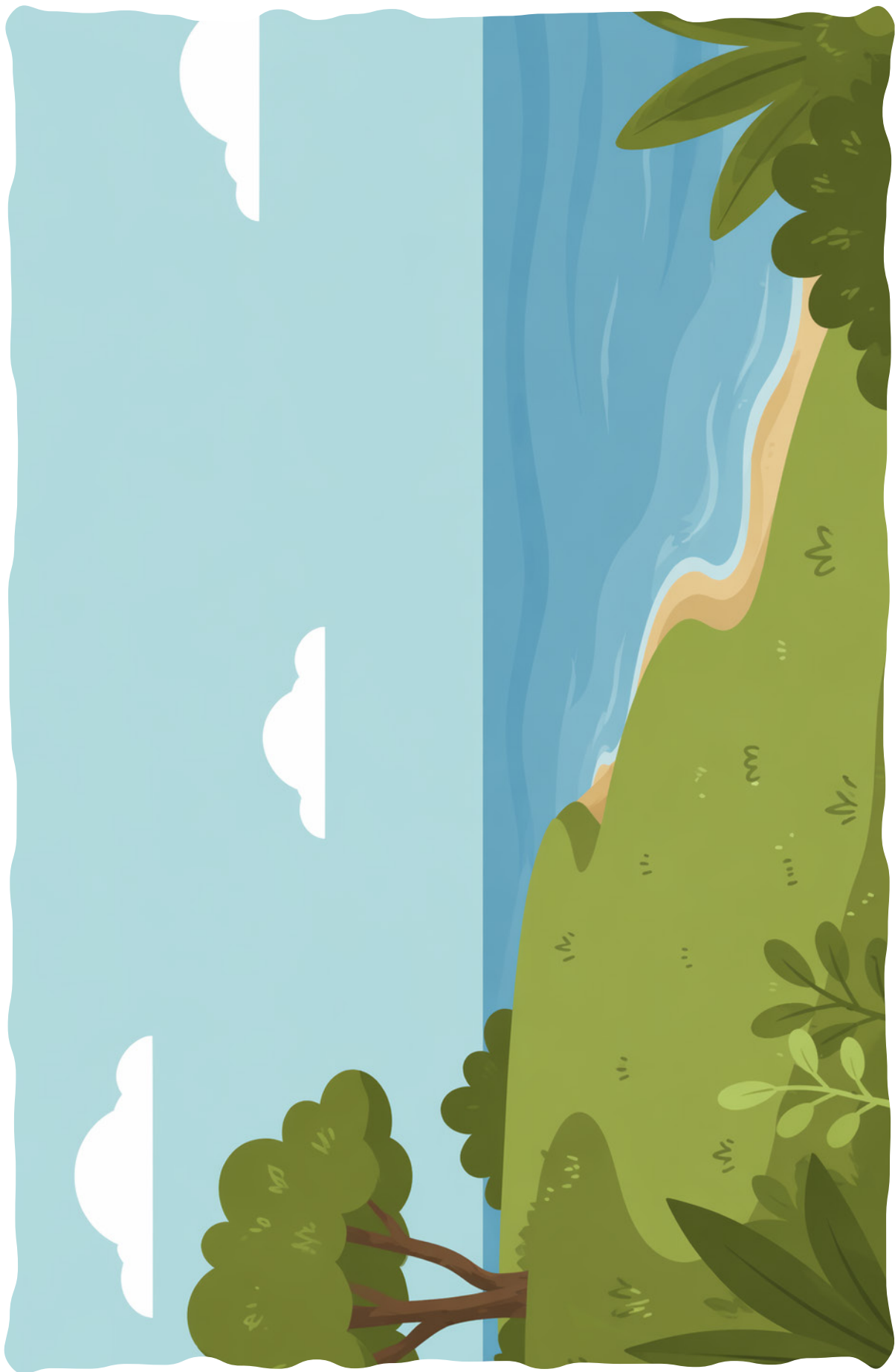

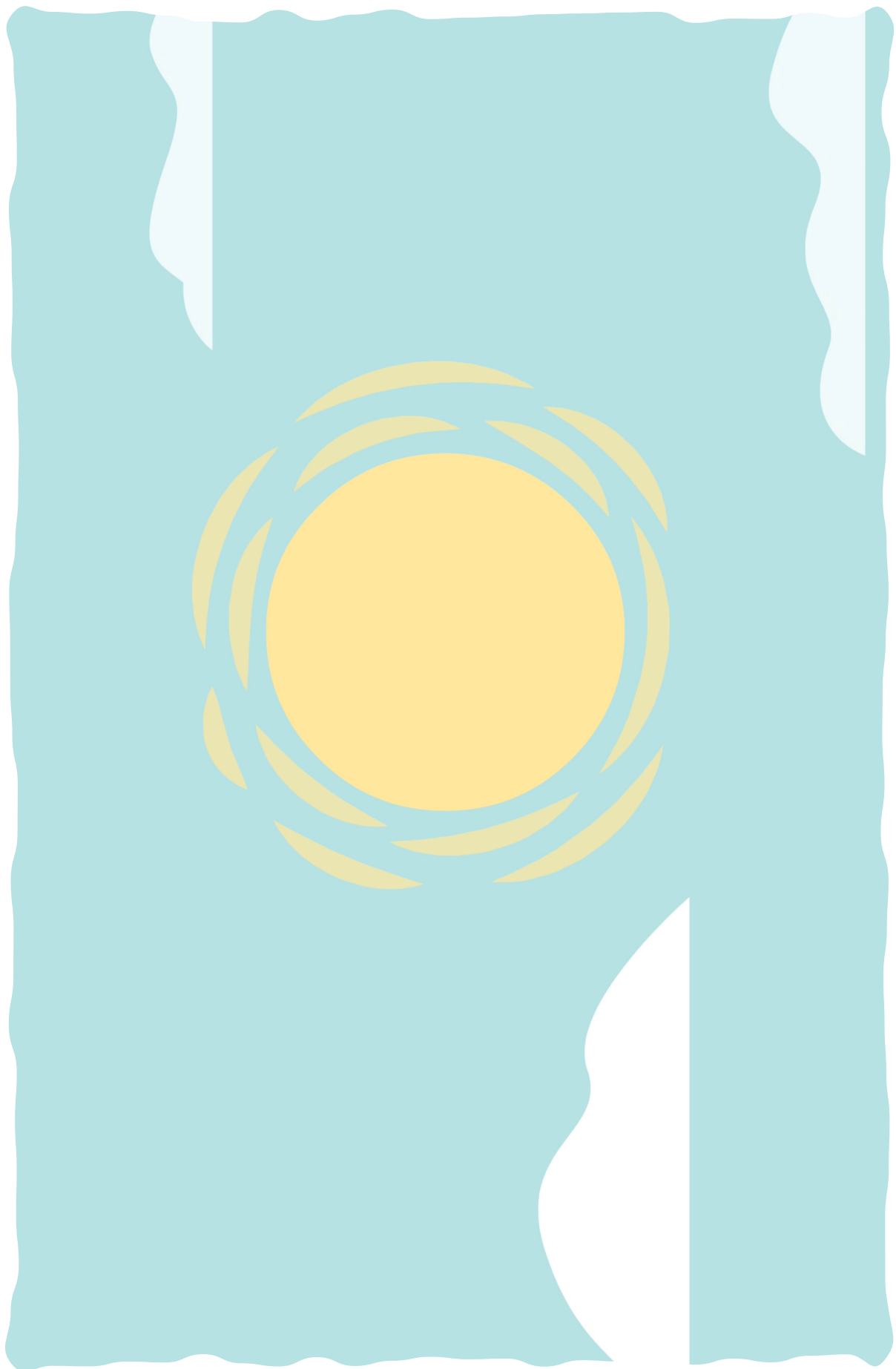

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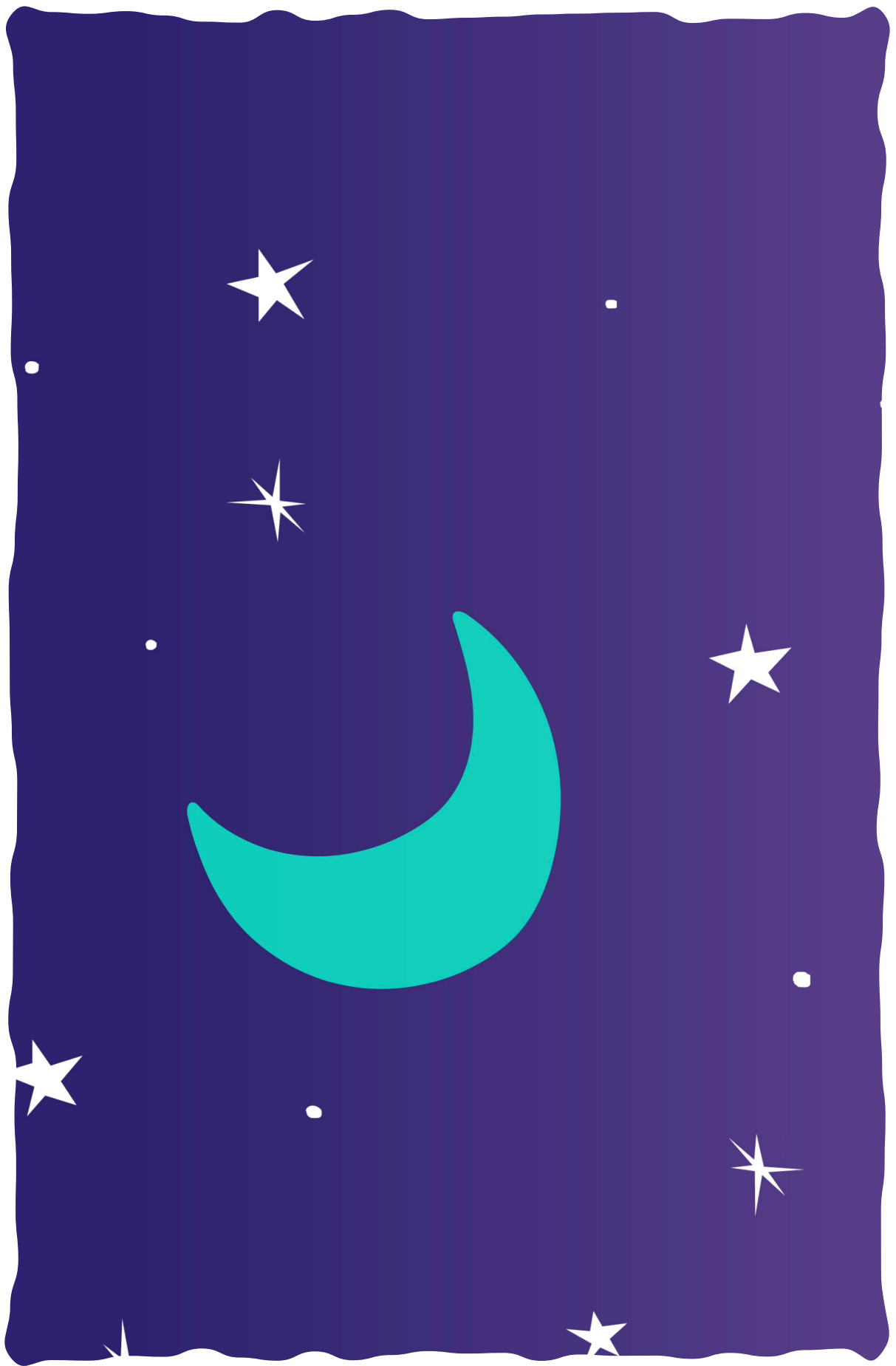

LEADER:* *"Hello, friends! I'm so happy to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's story from the Bible *(hold up the Bible) is about the very beginning when God made the world (draw a simple picture of the world) and everything in it.*

*"At first, there was nothing; then God created light. Then God made the land, plants, oceans, and sky. (Draw a simple picture of the land with grass, trees, and flowers. Wavy blue lines for the oceans.) He made the sun and the fluffy clouds in the day (draw a simple picture of the sun and fluffy clouds), and a beautiful moon and twinkling stars at night. (Draw a simple picture of the moon and stars.) God made it all, but that's not all. God made animals big and small, like elephants and lions (draw a simple picture of an elephant, and a lion), turtles and grasshoppers too. (Draw a simple picture of a turtle and a grasshopper.) The whole earth is filled with God's creation, and He takes care of it all. But that's still not all God made. God made people! That means God made you! (Draw a stick figure or smiley face and name each child.) [Child's name] **[Bottom Line]** God made you wonderful." (Repeat with each child's name.)*

Wow! These are amazing. Let's add the picture of you right in the center of your frame. (Help glue and stick child's picture in the middle of the child's frame.) Yay, hooray, it's you! **[Bottom Line] God made you wonderful."**

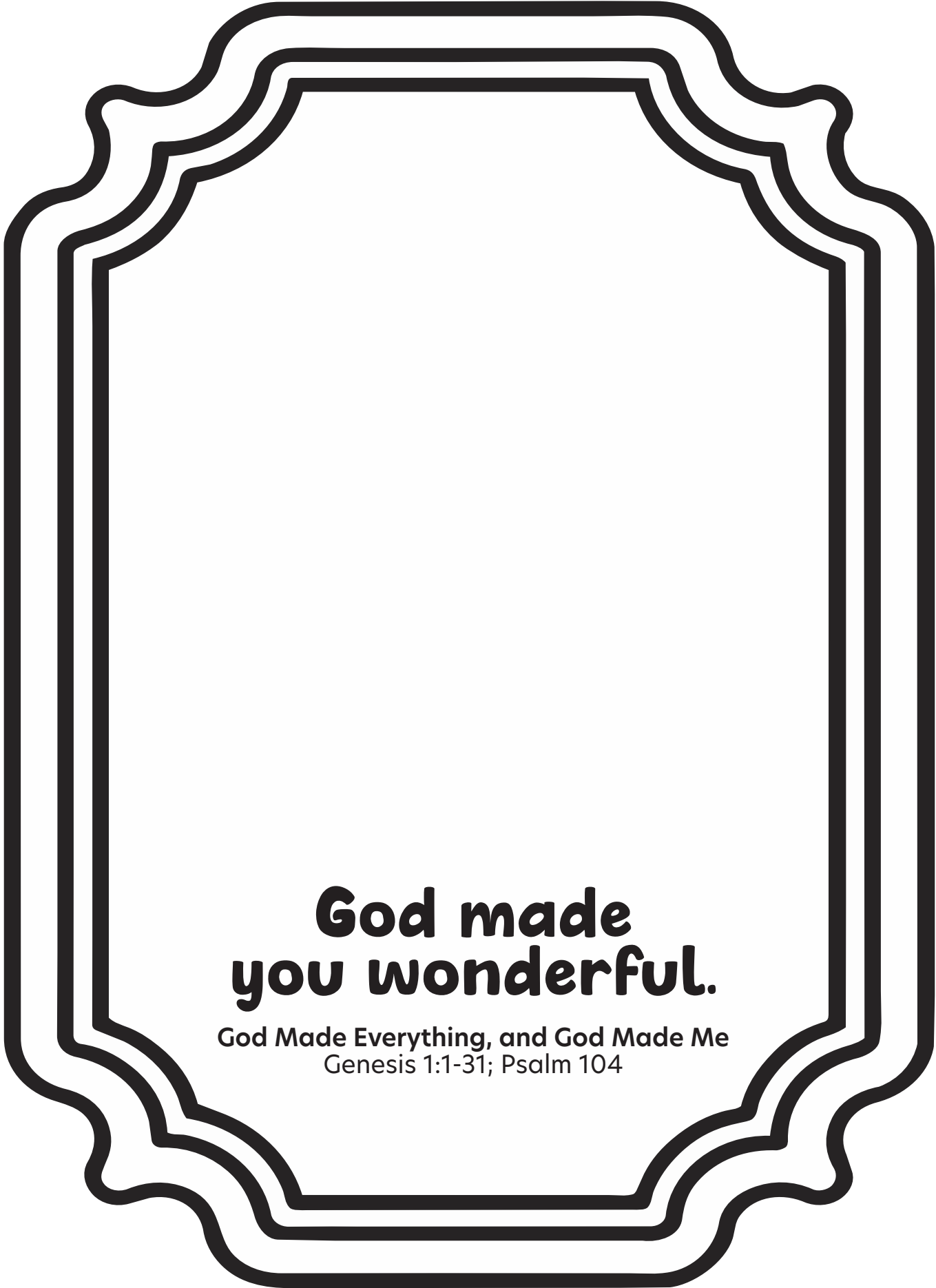

What You Say:

LEADER: *"*Hello, friends! I'm so happy to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's true story from the Bible *(hold up the Bible) is about the very beginning when God made the world and everything in it. Let's put motions to our story. Watch and do what I do.*

At first, there was nothing! Let's be very quiet. Shhh. *(One finger to your mouth and shh.)* Then God made light. God made land like big mountains *(make a triangle over your head with both hands)*, and God made the sky way up high! *(Stretch your arms way up high.)* God made the sun *(make a big circle with your arms over your head)* and the fluffy clouds that float in the sky. And God made the little twinkling stars *(make tiny open, close motions with your hands)* and the shiny moon to light the night.

"But that's not all God made! God made big, big elephants that trumpet with their trunks. *(Put your arm up to your nose like a trunk and make a trumpet sound.)* And God made little, tiny turtles that crawl super slow. *(Move one arm at a time in a slow crawling motion.)*

"God made everything! But the BEST thing God made was YOU! *(Point to all the children.)* **[Bottom Line] God made you wonderful!"**

Before the Activity: Print "The Whole World" on cardstock, one per child. Write each child's name on their paper.

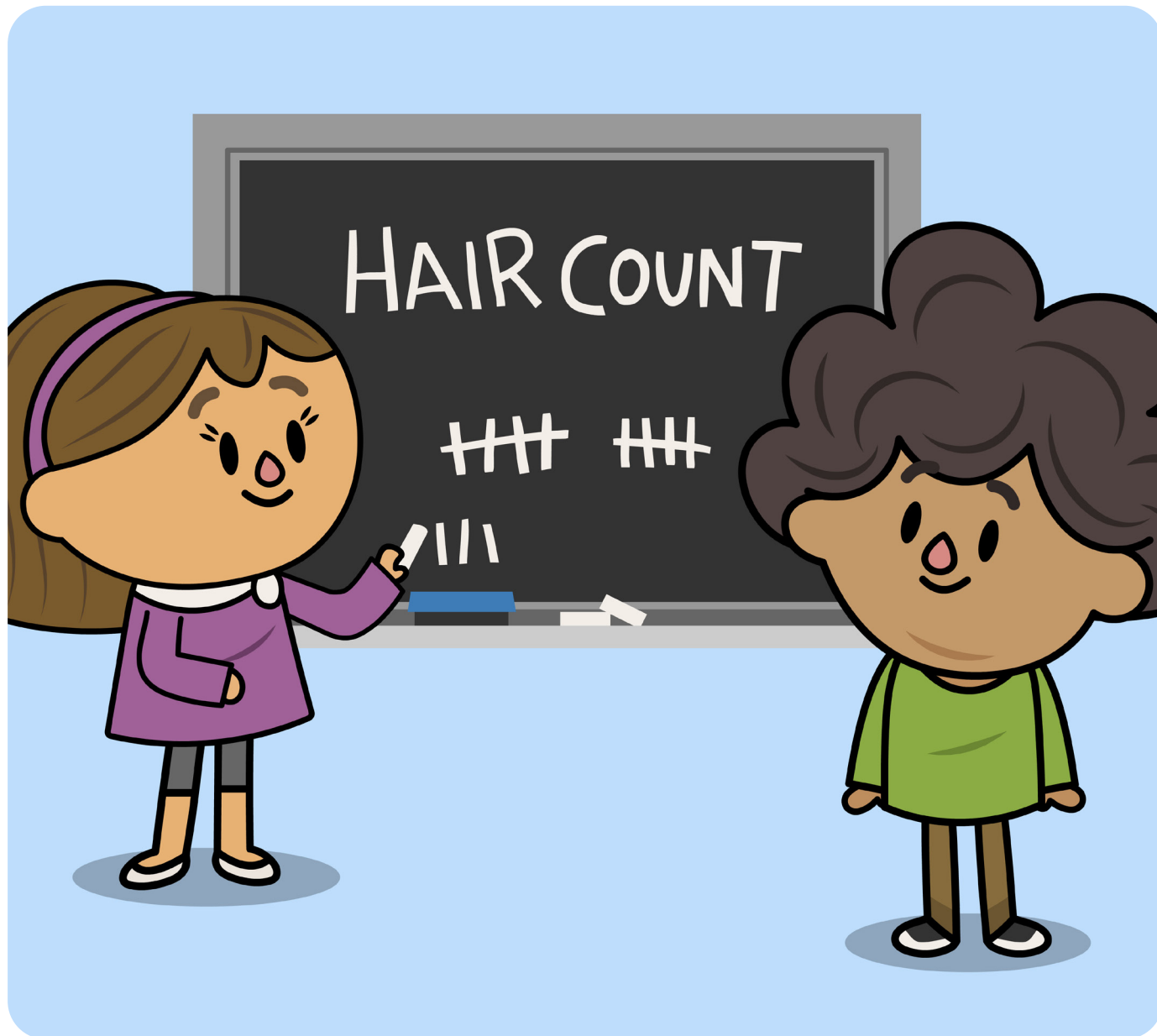
During the Activity: Encourage children to fill in the whole world with blue and green dot markers. Clean hands as needed.

What You Say:

During the Activity: "We learned that God made the whole world and everything in it! Look at this big circle with the squiggly lines inside. This is a picture of the world. Let's add some color to it. Can you add some blue dots for water? *(Pause.)* Great! Now let's add some green for the land. *(Pause.)* Wonderful! *(Clean hands as needed.)* We can look around and see all the beautiful and wonderful things God has created ... but God's greatest creation of all is YOU. **[Bottom Line] God made you wonderful."**

- Print "Creation Stickers" on label paper, one set of stickers per Small Group.
- As you review, place the sticker on the ball.

What You Say:

LEADER: * *"Hello, friends! I'm so happy to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's true story from the Bible *(hold up the Bible) is about the very beginning when God made the world (Hold up the globe ball) and everything in it.*

*"At first, there was nothing; then God created light. (Add the light sticker.) Then God made the land (add the land sticker), plants and flowers (add the plants/flowers sticker), oceans (add the water sticker), and sky. He made the sun and the fluffy clouds in the day (add the sun, clouds sticker) and a beautiful moon and twinkling stars at night. (Add the night sky sticker) God made it all, but that's not all. God made animals big and small, like elephants (add the elephant and lion sticker) and lions, turtles and grasshoppers too. (Add the turtle and grasshopper sticker.) The whole earth is filled with God's creation, and He takes care of it all. But that's still not all God made. God made people! (Add the people stickers.) That means God made you! [Child's name], point to something on the ball. (Name any sticker close to where they pointed.) You pointed to the [sticker]. God made [sticker]! (Continue with each child or as interest allows. Toss the ball in the air and catch it.) God made the whole world and everything in it, and God made you! **[Bottom Line] God made you wonderful."***

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Creation Book" on cardstock, one per child. Fold each child's paper and write their name. Cut mirror paper to fit on the back, one per child.

During the Activity: Encourage children to add heart stamps to each page. Help children glue the mirror paper to their book. Clean hands as needed.

What You Say:

During the Activity: "Today in our story, we learned that God made the whole world and everything in it. Let's decorate your book about God's awesome creations. You can add a heart stamp to each part of creation. I see land, water, and plants and trees. *(Pause.)* I see water and the sun and fluffy clouds. *(Pause.)* I see water and the moon and twinkly stars. I see animals really big and really small. *(Pause.)* Turn to the last page of your amazing book. (Flip to the back of the book) Let's glue this special paper to your book. *(Help children rub glue on the back of their mirror paper and press onto their paper.)* It's a mirror! Look inside to see God's most special creation. *(Pause.)* That's you! **[Bottom Line] God made you wonderful."**

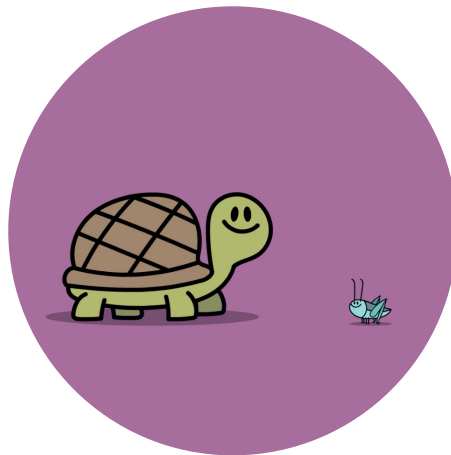
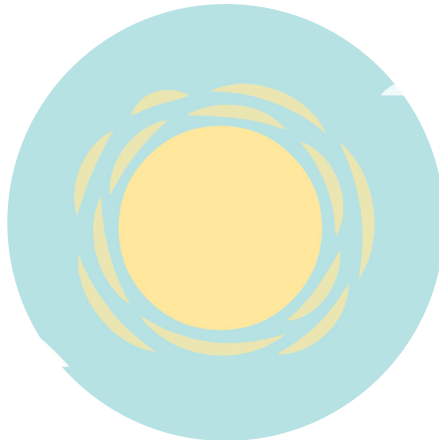
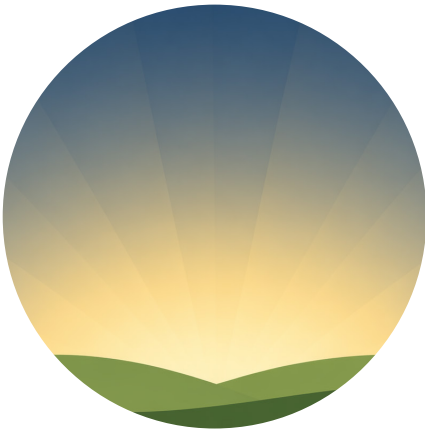
