The Shoot Out Series is a tournament circuit with each state/ holding five qualifying shoots. Each archer builds a national ranking score based on their top three tournaments. The scores are then combined with scores across the United States and then ranked and the top eight archers invited to come to the finale called "The Gauntlet." At the National Gauntlet, archers shoot in a single elimination setting with the archers from the bottom ranking shooting against the next highest ranked archer.
