3 give

Prayerfully make a commitment that stretches your faith. Turn in your family commitment card on November 12. Then, starting on December 3, begin to give in ways that change our families, our church, and our neighbors.

Whether you're brand-new or have been giving to CCC for a long time, we're not asking you to give everything away; we're just asking you to prayerfully consider taking that next step forward.

# FAQ frequently asked questions

# IS DEFINING MOMENTS JUST A WAY TO RAISE MORE MONEY?

Defining Moments is a way for us to express our gratitude to God for all the resources He has given us. We're working together to have an incredible impact to our community. This initiative is not about collecting extra tithes; it's all about faithfully stepping together as one church to care for our families, our church, and our neighbors.

# HOW DOES THE ONE FUND APPROACH TO DEFINING MOMENTS CHANGE MY GIVING TO SUPPORT THE GENERAL BUDGET, OUTREACH, FACILITIES, CAMPUS EXPANSION, AND OTHER SPECIAL OFFERINGS?

During this two year period, every contribution to God's work through Christ Community Church is a contribution to *Defining Moments*. Every aspect of the ministry vision God is calling us toward will be funded through this initiative. There will not be separate funds; every gift made will go into the same *Defining Moments* fund. Therefore, every weekend becomes an opportunity to celebrate and contribute toward what God is doing in and through CCC!

#### WHAT ARE YOU ASKING ME TO DO?

Most of all, we are asking you to step out in faith. Everyone who calls Christ Community Church home is being asked to make a two-year commitment. We serve a great God and trust Him to exceed our greatest expectations - to do more than we could ever hope or imagine through our collective *Defining Moments* commitments.

#### WHAT IF I CAN'T AFFORD TO GIVE RIGHT NOW?

Even in times of scarcity, God wants our hearts. The widow who gave her last mite did not make a very big financial contribution, but Jesus said she gave the largest gift of all. *Defining Moments* is about all of us coming together, giving generously, and trusting God to do the rest.

# WHAT IF I'M SEVERELY IN DEBT RIGHT NOW? AM I STILL SUPPOSED TO GIVE?

It's important for generosity to be a part of our life at every point. If you are in the process of paying off debt, we commend you, and you should continue to do so. But, the Bible does not teach that we withhold giving until we are debt-free. When we honor God first with our giving, He promises to be involved with every other aspect of finances.

# WHAT IF I'VE NEVER EVEN GIVEN TO CHRIST COMMUNITY CHURCH BEFORE?

If you have never given financially to CCC, *Defining Moments* is for you! *This* is a "one fund" generosity initiative. It is different from a traditional capital campaign where you are asked to give an extra gift "over and above" your regular giving. Rather, *Defining Moments* recognizes that everyone in the church is called to give generously and sacrificially. This is not merely for "super-givers;" it is for all of us.

#### **HOW DO I GIVE?**

There are three ways that you can contribute financially to CCC: online at ccconbell.com/give, at Sunday services during the collection of the offering, or by mailing your contribution to the church during the week.

### WHAT IF I AM NEW AROUND HERE?

We're excited that you are considering partnering with us! The local church is God's "Plan A" for conforming our families to the image of Christ, reaching our community, and bringing the gospel to the nations. If you are new to us, let this become your "defining moment" and join us in the mission.

# WHY DO CHURCHES TALK ABOUT MONEY, FINANCES, AND GIVING SO MUCH?

We talk about money because we care about you and your family. According to the Bible, money can bring great opportunity or great danger. Jesus tells us, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Matthew 6:19). We know that financial strain is a frequent tension in marriages and a leading cause of depression. As a church, generosity is not something we want FROM you, but something we want FOR you because Christ taught us that generosity changes our hearts and makes us more Kingdom-minded.

# HOW LONG WILL MY COMMITMENT BE? CAN I UPDATE MY COMMITMENT IF MY CIRCUMSTANCES CHANGE?
