DAY 1

Repentance / Submission

We all have need to humble ourselves from time to time. Prayer and fasting gets to the heart of the matter. One's resistance to it, known by the excuses we present ourselves, is the telltale sign of our need for it. The '5 R's of Repentance' are worthy to study: Recognition, Regret, Renounce, Reformation, and Restitution.

1 John 1:9—“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness...”

DAY 2

Power of the Holy Spirit / Supernatural

Prayer produces connection to the source of power. The early church was powerful, not from education or wealth, but from prayer alone.

Acts 4:31—“And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak the word of God with boldness.”

DAY 5

DAY 6
