

## From the Desk of Father Trowbridge



Dear Parishioners & Guests!

I pray that your Sunday is blessed. Through the course of any given week we confront many things that are out of our control. There is a memorable quote that our late-bishop, Thomas Doran, would share with us during seminary, "I have had plenty of bad days as a priest, but never a bad week."

This sentiment is in mind as I draw your attention to the importance of Sunday in our life of faith. When we give God priority on Sunday, it stands as an anchor for our life. When we hold Sunday Mass attendance as a non-negotiable we are honoring the first commandment *to honor God above all things*.

While this may impinge upon our life plans from time to time, it anchors us in any season of life that we may always have safe harbor with God. Additionally, it is a living sacrifice that shows by our actions that, yes, God is so important that we literally change our schedule so that we maintain our weekly holy sabbath union with Him in the Eucharist. Even the most faithful among us need to have this lesson refreshed.

I know other things pull on our schedule, this is why I remain grateful to pray together each week (or each day if your schedule permits it). This Sunday our gospel brings us to one of Jesus' favorite places to relax: the home of Lazarus, Martha and Mary in the town of Bethany. We are familiar with the scene of today's gospel. Mary is listening to Jesus while Martha is busy with the tasks of a hostess. Martha asks Jesus to have Mary help her. Jesus declines saying, "Mary has chosen the better part and it shall not be taken from her."

Let us compare what each of our friends of Jesus were doing: Mary was attentive to Jesus. Martha was attentive to details in the home, also for Jesus. Mary was listening to Jesus' words. Martha was making the details of the home presentable. Both are acts of attentiveness, done out of love and care, but Jesus identifies that Mary's posture was better than Martha's. This is not to say Martha's posture was bad, however Mary had chosen the better part and it shall not be disrupted.

I pray that in the busy reality of our life we never become so busy that we forget why we are doing what we do. Sometimes we can be tempted to separate from God, not by evil things, but by "less good" things. This is why our conscience must remain calibrated and precise in daily prayer, the reading of sacred scripture, regular confession with a good examination of conscience, reverent reception of Our Lord in Holy Communion, and good ol' gospel living.

You're doing great, keep it up!

## **Sacraments**

## **Anointing of the Sick**

Anointing of the sick is to be celebrated at different times of illness:

- 1) when a person becomes ill
- 2) when a persisting illness gets worse
- 3) before any surgery
- 4) when death is immanent

This celebration of the sacrament seeks physical recovery and spiritual strength during the healing journey. God's grace at this time is a comfort to the soul.

There is a final celebration of Anointing of the Sick which is before death when the recipient is still alert and can receive Holy Communion. This is Anointing and Viaticum. Viaticum refers to the final reception of Holy Communion before going to the Lord.

Something special during this celebration is the Apostolic Pardon. This is a prayer connected to absolution which forgives the time a soul is due to endure in purgatory. This is a permission given by the Holy See as an act of the Church's mercy for souls close to death. Always ask a priest for the Apostolic Pardon!

Many times in my priesthood I have been asked to anoint a parishioner and they were non-responsive, sedated and unable to be alert for the sacrament. Tell your family, "If I go to the hospital, call father. I want to be anointed when I am alert and aware!"

If you or someone you know is not alert or aware during the anointing of the sick, that is okay. you can have them anointed. It certainly still counts as a validly celebrated sacrament.

## Marriage

This sacrament is the foundation of family life and is always celebrated as a sacrament in our Catholic life. Couples planning to be married should contact the parish before finalizing with their reception venue. At a minimum, contact the parish six months prior to your proposed wedding date.

### **Baptism**

Please baptize your children as soon as possible. Parents seeking baptism for their child must bring a copy of the birth certificate to the parish office and register for a baptism preparation class. Classes are held on the second Sunday of the month following the 10:00 a.m. Mass.
