

From the Desk of Father Trowbridge



Dear Parishiners & Suests!

I pray that your Sunday is restful for you and your loved ones. Our Lord commanded that this may be a day of rest so that you could be restored in your deepest identity: *your relationship with God*. It is similar to a parent expecting their child to make their bed and clean their room, while it may be a sacrifice in the moment, the orderliness will be a blessing for the rest of the day.

Our Sunday rest ties in with the life of our gospel. We are called to detach from the interests of the world so that the priority of God may be manifest in our life; all of this for our eternal benefit. A few brief statements from the Catechism of the Catholic Church assist us in this priority. "The Sunday celebration of the Lord's Day and his Eucharist is at the heart of the Church's life." "The institution of the Lord's Day helps everyone enjoy adequate rest and leisure to cultivate their familial, cultural, social, and religious lives [2177 & 2184]

With these truths and all truths from Church teaching, we pray that our hearts may be supple when they encounter God's call to deeper conversion, deeper fidelity to His truth. All of this so that we may be more charitable to one another in this moment and be increased in our hope for our eternal rest in God. And so we pray the words of our Responsorial Psalm from today, "if today you hear His voice, harden not your hearts." Ps 95

We are exposed to many events, news stories, opinions and ideas. It is good for us to be refreshed and reminded by Our Lord, as we are in the gospel this Sunday, that we are to be rich in what matters to God by guarding against greed.

It was nice to be with Deacon Brian this past Monday for our first OCIA Inquiry Night. This information session is an opportunity to meet those who are interested in entering into the Catholic life with full sacramental communion. I know there are a few more people in our community who are on the periphery who are hungering for Our Lord. I pray that your eyes and conversations may be opened to invite people in your circles of life to be in touch with Deacon Brian so they can learn more and hopefuly join us in the life of grace. Our next Inquiry night for OCIA is August 25th, Monday night at 6:00 pm. I pray that the Lord uses you as an instrument to draw all souls more closely to Him.

It is good to see that Deacon Bill is back in action after his hip surgery. Some of you know that experience. Doctors want us to resume regular activity as quickly as possible, but wisely. To all of our parishioners who are in the thick of health issues, I want you to know that each day our parish rosary includes the intention for you to "be at peace rooted strongly in the Lord that He may guard you against all discouragement and despair through the trials of ill health."

I am excited to see such a great response on facebook to our parish welcome video. It is the same video that I shared with you through our parish Christmas cards a few months ago. In a week we have had about 3,500 views inviting people to pray with us! I pray this message bears fruit for the strength of the faithful.

In a few weeks we will debut our new website. Jenny has been working diligently in the background these past many months building this site for us and we are near completion. It will be a great interface to connect our families and community to the life of our parish family!
