



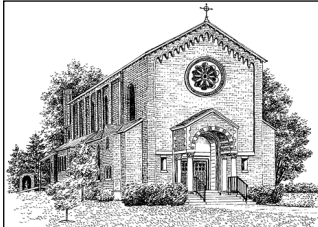

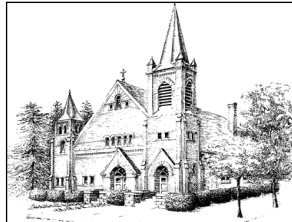

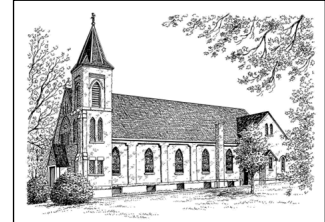

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As we continue to make our way through the Easter Season, it is also the time the bishop celebrates the Sacrament of Confirmation throughout the Diocese. On Thursday, April 16, young men and women from our parish and in our neighboring parishes gathered at St. Mary's to celebrate Confirmation with our new bishop! It is always a beautiful evening and the culmination of much preparation by the family and the parish. I am very proud of each of them and enjoyed presenting them to the bishop for this great sacrament.

Most people probably cannot articulate exactly what Confirmation is as a sacrament, or at least what its effects are. This is a good time for some catechesis. We see in Scripture the significance of the act of laying-on-of-hands and the conferral of the Holy Spirit. One of the main texts used to illustrate this is Acts 8:14-17:

“Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, who went down and prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Spirit, for it had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then they laid hands on them and they received the Holy Spirit.”

Notice how it is *an apostle* who lays hands on the baptized so they receive the Holy Spirit. The bishops, the Successors of the Apostles have this same authority today. The prayer that the bishop says as he extends his hands over the confirmands is:

“Almighty God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who brought these servants to new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, freeing them from sin: send upon them, O Lord, the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete; give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and fortitude, the spirit of knowledge and piety; fill them with the spirit of fear of the Lord. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.”

Besides this prayer, the sacrament is conferred by the anointing with the Chrism Oil (blessed at the Chrism mass during Holy Week), and the prayer: “N., Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit.” The Gifts of the Holy Spirit further perfect the virtues (theological and cardinal) within us so that we can operate on an even higher level, more attentive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit and His work within us.

Further, Confirmation strengthens us to be able to preserve the Faith we have been given and to profess and defend the Faith in our daily lives, according to our circumstances. We traditionally say that one becomes a “soldier of Christ” as one who has a duty to evangelize and promote the Faith. The Cross traced with the Chrism on the forehead of the confirmand is like a military standard that defines our identity and directs our life.

Please join me in again congratulating our confirmands and praying for them and their families!
