







FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Below is "The Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ from the Roman Martyrology" that is typically sung during the Liturgy of the Hours or before the Christmas Mass During the Night. It begins with creation and relates the birth of the Lord to the major events and personages of sacred and secular history. It is a beautiful meditation on God's Providence throughout history and His plan to bring each of us to Him, through Christ.

In this Octave of Christmas, leading to the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, we still meditate on the birth of Our Lord and marvel how the world has been prepared for His coming. May we be found watchful when He comes again in glory.

The Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ

The Twenty-fifth Day of December,
 when ages beyond number had run their course
 from the creation of the world,
 when God in the beginning created heaven and earth,
 and formed man in his own likeness;
 when century upon century had passed
 since the Almighty set his bow in the clouds after the Great Flood,
 as a sign of covenant and peace;
 in the twenty-first century since Abraham, our father in faith,
 came out of Ur of the Chaldees;
 in the thirteenth century since the People of Israel were led by Moses
 in the Exodus from Egypt;
 around the thousandth year since David was anointed King;
 in the sixty-fifth week of the prophecy of Daniel;
 in the one hundred and ninety-fourth Olympiad;
 in the year seven hundred and fifty-two
 since the foundation of the City of Rome;
 in the forty-second year of the reign of Caesar Octavian Augustus,
 the whole world being at peace,

JESUS CHRIST, eternal God and Son of the eternal Father,
 desiring to consecrate the world by his most loving presence,
 was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
 and when nine months had passed since his conception,
 was born of the Virgin Mary in Bethlehem of Judah,
 and was made man:

The Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ according to the flesh.





