



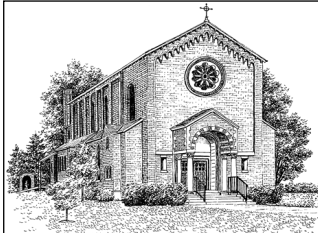

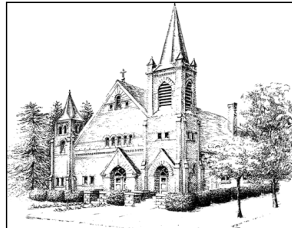

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Now that we have had the unofficial beginning of Summer, we look forward to all the activities that we enjoy with family, friends, and fellow parishioners. As you know, next Sunday is our annual *Corpus Christi* procession and Parish Picnic. It will be a particularly special celebration this year as we also celebrate the 130th Anniversary of the consecration of St. Felix Church. It is important that we have as many parishioners as possible attend this celebration. Anyone who has been to our parish picnic in previous years knows how great a celebration it is, and how much fun we have spending that time together on a summer day. I encourage people to bring any sporting equipment that could be used in a park, as we will have plenty of room for any kind of activity.

Having this celebration of St. Felix Church centered around *Corpus Christi* is important as it is Christ present Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity who is the center of our life and of our churches. He has sustained our church and community here for all these years, and so we honor Him as our King as we process from the church to the park.

There is a special Mass schedule next Sunday which I have repeatedly announced. The information is everywhere where one would be expected to find such information, but here are the details for next **Sunday, June 7:**

8:00am – St. Dominic

10:00am – St. Felix (followed by Eucharistic Procession to John Brown Park)

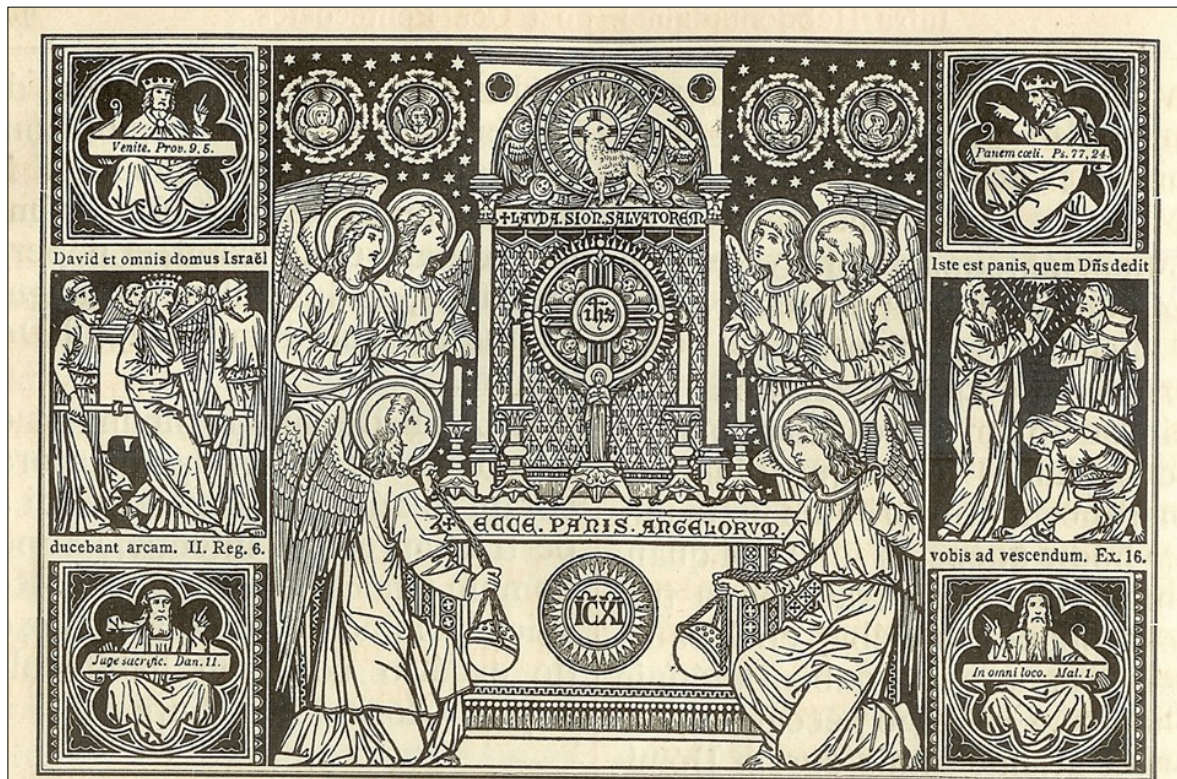
NO MASS AT NOON

I really look forward to celebrating this tremendous milestone with you all!

Last Sunday I mentioned the idea of slightly changing a couple of the Sunday Mass times by tightening the schedule. I asked for some feedback as to whether people thought that was a good idea, and all feedback I have received was positive so far. The idea is that, because the 8:00am Mass is shorter, I would be able to start Mass at St. Francis at 9:30am without much difficulty. This would allow the Mass at St. Dominic to begin at 11:30am. That half-hour shift may not seem like much, but I think almost everyone would want to start Mass before noon on a Sunday. And so, again, here is the proposed Sunday schedule: *8:00am at St. Felix; 9:30am at St. Francis; 11:30am at St. Dominic*. If anyone has any strong opinions on this either way, let me know. I have talked to quite a few people, as well as those on Parish Council, and people are in favor. I would plan to implement this schedule sometime before the end of summer.

Finally, the roof replacement project at St. Felix is well underway and it is absolutely beautiful. If you have not seen it, I hope you love it as much as I do. I would put pictures in the bulletin here, but since we print them in black and white, you would not see much detail. I will make a photo album on the main page of the website for you to see.

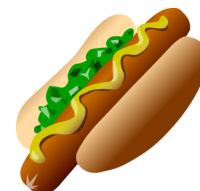
Join us for a special morning & afternoon celebrating the great history of St. Felix Church & the faith of our community!
