

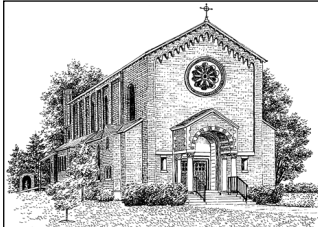

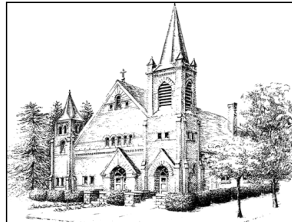

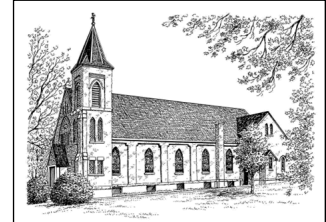

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Merry Christmas and Happy Epiphany to you and your families!

First, I simply want to thank you for your tremendous generosity in all the gifts and cards you have given me. I truly appreciate it.

I also want to thank everyone who took the time to decorate our beautiful churches for the Christmas Season. Our churches are already very beautiful, but taking the time to enhance their beauty to signal to us the Birth of Christ is a gift to all of us as our minds and hearts are elevated by such beauty and by the joy that Christmas brings. I am sure the visitors to our parish during our Christmas Masses also greatly appreciated coming to our home and worshipping with us.

Remember that Christmas is not just one day, but a Season in the Church's year. It is through this Mystery of the Incarnation through which we view the events of Our Lord's life that we will celebrate in the coming weeks.

To prepare us for the Epiphany, here is another reflection from Dom Prosper Guéranger:

“Let us, then, open our hearts to the Joy of this grand Day; and on this Feast of the *Theophany*, of the *Holy Lights*, of the *Three Kings*, let us look with love at the dazzling beauty of our Divine Sun, who, as the Psalmist expresses it [Ps. xviii. 6], runs his course as a Giant, and pours out upon us floods of a welcome and yet most vivid light. The Shepherds, who were called by the Angels to be the first worshippers, have been joined by the Prince of Martyrs [December 26], the Beloved Disciple [December 27], the dear troop of Innocents [December 28], our glorious Thomas of Canterbury [December 29], and Sylvester the Patriarch of Peace [December 31]; and now, to-day, these Saints open their ranks to let the Kings of the East come to the Babe in his crib, bearing with them the prayers and adorations of the whole human race. The humble Stable is too little for such a gathering as this, and Bethlehem seems to be worth all the world besides. Mary, the Throne of the divine Wisdom, welcomes all the members of this court with her gracious smile of Mother and Queen; she offers her Son to man, for his adoration, and to God, that he may be well pleased. God *manifests* himself to men, because he is great: but he *manifests* himself by Mary, because he is full of mercy.”
