



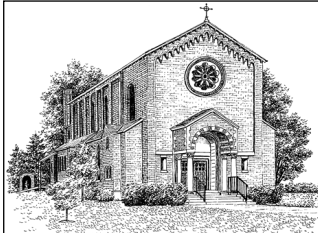

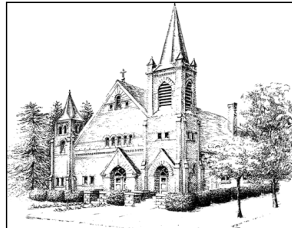

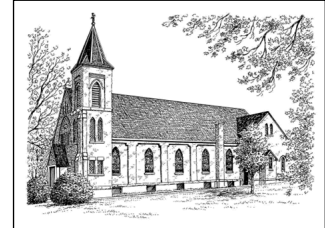

## FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

There are many blessings that we celebrate during this Easter Season that are worth mentioning. First, today is Mother's Day! "Thank you" to all of our mothers for the work you do and sacrifices you make to raise your children and to care for others. May God reward you!

Also, last weekend we celebrated the First Communion of nine of our children. This is always one of my favorite Masses of the year. Everyone is just so happy and excited, and the children, though nervous, know what a special moment this is in their life of faith. It is Holy Mother Church feeding these children with the Bread of Life for the first time. I included a few pictures here.

Besides Mother's Day, we celebrate the entire month of May as dedicated to the Most Holy Virgin Mary, Mother of God and our Mother! We know that we have an Advocate who pleads for us with her Divine Son, who truly cares for us with a mother's love, more perfect than any mother.

St. Ildephonsus of Toledo, a 7<sup>th</sup> century bishop wrote a beautiful little book called *Crown of the Virgin*, in which he imagines a crown of gold with a combination of twenty-four precious stones and flowers, each representing some aspect of Mary's beauty, virtue, and eminent sanctity. He begins his praises:

"In the longing of my soul, in the joy of the Holy Spirit, in the most genuine love, and in the Word of Truth, I wish to extol you, to praise you, and to bless you, O Virgin Mary! For you are more radiant than the Sun; in appearance, you are more beautiful; in faith and grace, you are richer. Indeed, you are the most beautiful of all created beings; and serene, radiant, and pleasing, as lovable as the fragrant rose, wholly entrancing and utterly attractive. Such is your dignity and excellence, that were I in possession of the tongues of humans and angels, and understood all hidden mysteries, and had all the knowledge of Scripture, these resources should fail me long before I had succeeded in expressing even the beginnings of the praise due to you. For you indeed are incomparably above all women in beauty, in gracefulness, and in elegance. You surpass all mortals in virtue, grace, and wisdom. You are more glorious than the angels themselves in eminence of dignity, in excellence of holiness, and in command of glory and honor. Exalted above the choirs of angels, above the thrones of the apostles and the prophets, and above all heavenly beings, you sit – crowned as Queen, at the right hand of your most beloved Son!"

When we love Mary, we find every way to praise her and no praise is too high for the Queen of Heaven!
