



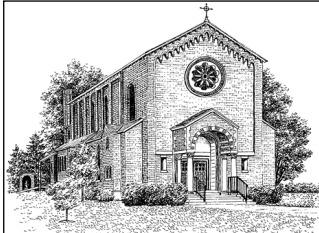

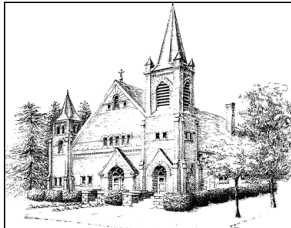

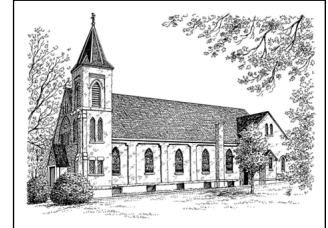

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ! This feast day, formerly known as *Corpus Christi*, is one of the great days in the year when we celebrate the mystery of our Lord's incomprehensible love for us.

The work of St. Thomas Aquinas is crucial to the celebration of this feast day. His philosophy and theology gave us the language for our Eucharistic devotion. One of the most beautiful hymns is his *Adoro te devote*. What follows is parts of a homily I gave last year on the feast of St. Thomas, celebrating the 800th anniversary of his birth.

Here is one of my favorite lines from the *Adoro te devote*, from the end of the hymn:

“Jesus, whom now I see hidden, I ask You to fulfill what I so desire: That the sight of Your Face being unveiled I may have the happiness of seeing Your glory. Amen.”

These lines capture the very heart of Eucharistic Adoration: the desire to see beyond the sacramental veil to the very reality we adore. When it comes to St. Thomas, we can discuss all day, and weeks and years, all his academic accomplishments and the fine points of his philosophy and theology. But more important than his monumental achievements in theology, St. Thomas knew that it all must lead to the mystery of the love of God living within us, expressed in true adoration of the living God. That's the point of everything he had ever written. Poetry and song have a way of bringing out the profound depths of theology in a way that moves one so much deeper than mere curiosity. It can move one to love, to sacrifice, and on a visceral level, to tears.

And these tears that one may shed can be both joy and sorrow at the same time. Joy, because the one we love is before us, and sorrow because we have not yet let His Love transform us into who He wants us to be. When I read the writings of St. Thomas, or sing the hymns he wrote, I try to see there the heart of the man who could write such things. You cannot write something this beautiful unless you believe it. There is something more here than mere rational thought. There is a vision of the world, of the whole universe really, that is enlightened from on High. It is a vision that sees all of reality permeated by the presence of its Creator, as everything bears His fingerprints.

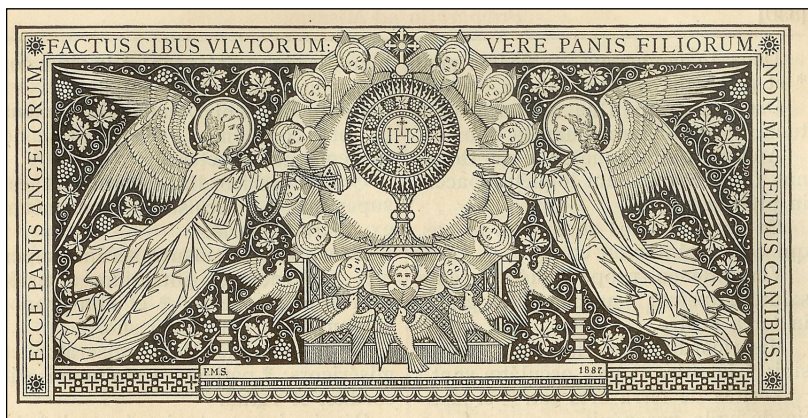
But nothing in the universe bears such fingerprints more so than you and I. And so, for man it is natural to want to reach out, beyond ourselves, to transcend this realm of sensation to what is currently unseen, yet knowable by the light of Faith. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is not just a prayer that merely reminds us of the things God has done for us, where we come together to pray, to venerate the saints, and so forth. It is all that, but so much more than that. It is our participation in the worship of God around His very throne. We enter into a reality that we did not create...Really True Reality (if I may put it that way), into which we are invited to participate.

It is good to be aware of the fact that our sojourn on this earth, our moral life, a life of virtue, and the sacramental life, are simultaneous. We are constantly on this journey, this pilgrimage to our heavenly homeland. But along the way, and at every moment, through the grace that comes to us in the Sacraments, we already have a foretaste of eternal life right here and now. God lives in us, and He has prepared a place for us with all the Saints.

With every word from these hymns by St. Thomas, you feel his profound sense of longing, of holy desire for His God and His Redeemer. He knew so well that the veil between time and eternity, between the joy of this life, and beatitude in the next, is only wafer-thin. What appears to our senses to be a translucent piece of bread, is our gateway into the Holy of Holies. With every syllable of these hymns, with St. Thomas, we have to let ourselves be pulled into the Tabernacle, the very furnace of the Lord's Love for us in every church.

Let this same love of our Eucharistic Lord that animated every breath of the life of St. Thomas, draw us forward towards eternity.
