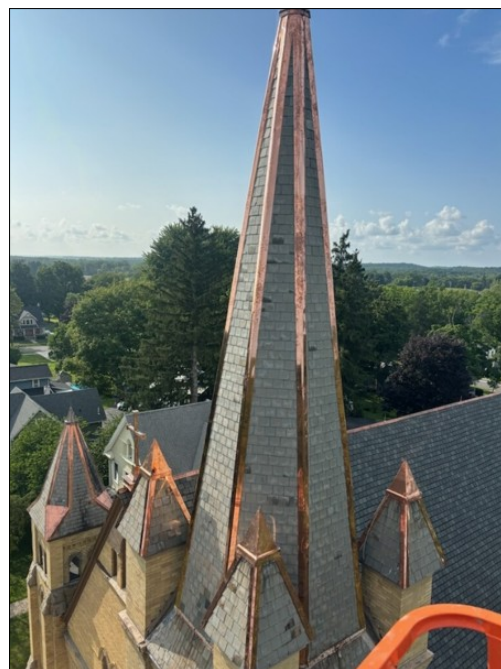
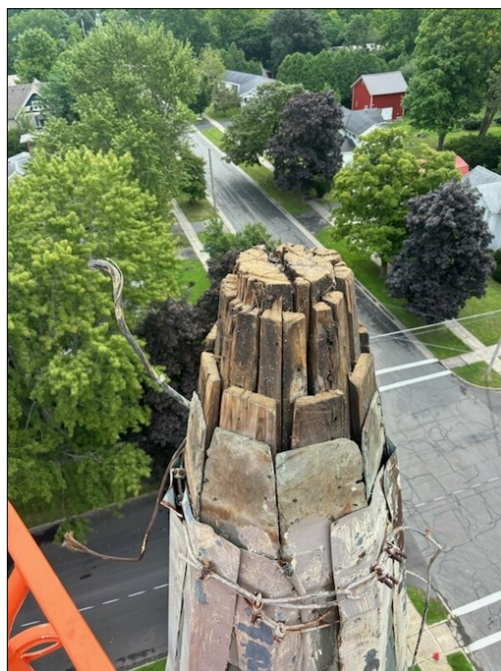
FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

This week, I just want to share with you that roof project at St. Felix is finally complete! The last part was the large steeple, but its completion was delayed due to the roofer's other projects and the availability of the 120-ft. lift. If you are reading this in print, you can enjoy the views of Clifton Springs from the top of the steeple, but I encourage you to see the bulletin on our website to see the pictures in color. Better yet, stop by St. Felix to see the beautiful copper that lines the church and steeples, brilliantly shining in the sunlight.

Besides the new roof and the copper lining, one of the most exciting parts of this project is that we now have a Cross restored on top of the high steeple, as it used to be a long time ago. It can be seen from all around, and it is a privilege to have this project completed and to preserve this church for many years to come.

We have done many maintenance and improvement projects over these last five years, but this is the largest one by far. While there are more projects to do in order to improve our churches and Parish Center, I want to thank you all for your continued support and love of the parish. None of this happens without you. The parish exists for the people. And our churches exist to have a fitting place to worship and glorify God, to serve as a witness to God's presence in each location, and to be a beacon for those searching for their way home.

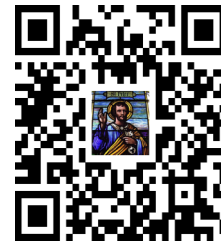
