



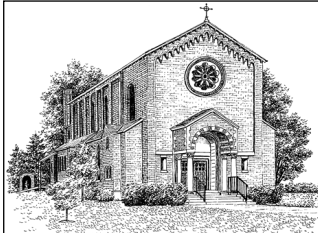

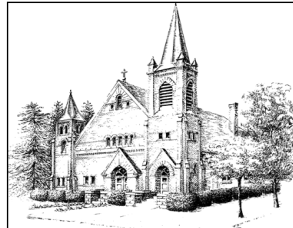

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

I think we are fortunate to live in one of the few parts of the country that keep the Solemnity of the Ascension on Thursday, instead of transferring it to this Sunday. There have been many things that we sacrifice for the sake of convenience, but reliving the forty days of Easter after the Resurrection, and then the additional ten days after the Ascension until Pentecost is simply following the biblical timeline as given to us in Acts of the Apostles 1:3-5:

He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for “the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

At this moment, we are in the midst of this time where the Lord has ascended to heaven, but the Holy Spirit has yet to come. The Apostles with the Blessed Virgin Mary “devoted themselves with one accord to prayer” (1:14) until the Holy Spirit came upon them and the Apostles began to preach with that anointing. From the time of the Ascension of the Lord until the Vigil of Pentecost (many major feast days used to have a “vigil,” separate from the feast day itself) is nine days.

You may be familiar with practice of a “novena.” It is the practice of praying for some particular intention, or with some devotion to a saint or one of the mysteries of our Faith, for nine days, ending on the day before the feast day. There have been many different novenas throughout the history of the Church that have proliferated among the faithful, but the “first novena” is the time from the Ascension until the Vigil of Pentecost, where the Apostles spent that time in prayer with the Blessed Virgin Mary, preparing for the coming of the Holy Spirit.

Although by the time you read this we will be two or three days into the novena, you can still participate in this week leading up to Pentecost. The purpose of the novena is to renew our devotion to God the Holy Spirit, to pray for the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit (wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord), and that we can show forth all Twelve Fruits of the Holy Spirit (charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, chastity). Also, like the Apostles, we want to be with the Blessed Virgin Mary.



There are many different ways to pray a novena to the Holy Spirit, so if you search for one, you will find different versions. One way is simply to pray the sequence for Pentecost (sung before the Gospel), the ancient hymn *Veni Sancte Spiritus*. You could also pray the following prayer, from Friday after the Ascension to the Vigil of Pentecost:

O Lord Jesus Christ, Who before ascending into Heaven didst promise to send the Holy Spirit to finish Thy work in the souls of Thine Apostles and Disciples, deign to grant the same Holy Spirit to me, that He may perfect in my soul the work of Thy grace and Thy love. Grant me the Spirit of Wisdom, that I may despise the perishable things of this world and aspire only after the things that are eternal; the Spirit of Understanding, to enlighten my mind with the light of Thy Divine truth; the Spirit of Counsel, that I may ever choose the surest way of pleasing God and gaining Heaven; the Spirit of Fortitude, that I may bear my cross with Thee and that I may overcome with courage all the obstacles that oppose my salvation; the Spirit of Knowledge, that I may know God and know myself and grow perfect in the science of the Saints; the Spirit of Piety, that I may find the service of God sweet and amiable; the Spirit of Fear, that I may be filled with a loving reverence towards God and may dread in any way to displease Him. Mark me, dear Lord, with the sign of Thy true disciples, and animate me in all things with Thy Spirit. Amen.
