



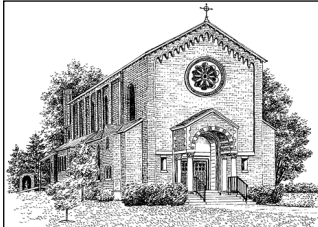

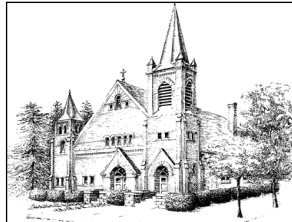

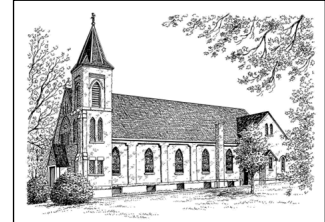

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As we continue into the second half of Easter, we have much to celebrate! This weekend we celebrate First Communions, which is always one of the most beautiful Masses of the year. Please pray for them as they welcome our Eucharistic Lord, their Divine Guest, in their body and soul for the first time! We also have the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord in a couple weeks, a holy day of obligation.

May is also a month specially dedicated to our Mother Mary. This is the perfect time to amplify or renew that devotion through good reading, committing to praying the Rosary, Marian Consecration, etc. Some examples of classic works on Marian devotion include *True Devotion to Mary* and *The Secret of the Rosary* by St. Louis de Montfort. *The Glories of Mary* by St. Alphonsus Liguori is also one of the best books on Marian devotion. Such books show us how a strong Marian devotion, far from distracting us from the love of Jesus, truly amplifies our love of our Lord and leads us deeper into His Sacred Heart.

Next week we also begin the replacement of the roof at St. Felix. For around 40 years or more the roof has been patched and fixed many times. It is finally time to secure the future of our church here in Clifton Springs for a long time to come. This is a historic moment in the life of St. Felix Church and of our parish as that church has now been serving the people of Clifton Springs for 130 years. Preparations are well under way for our *Corpus Christi*/Anniversary celebration on Sunday, June 7! Look for more information in the near future regarding those details.

Finally, last week I mentioned spending time with some sheep and the lambs. Included here are some pictures that you might enjoy!
