



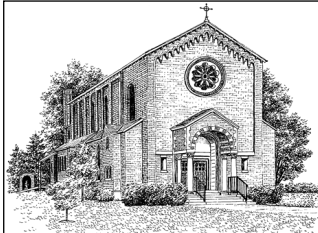

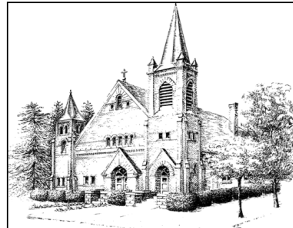

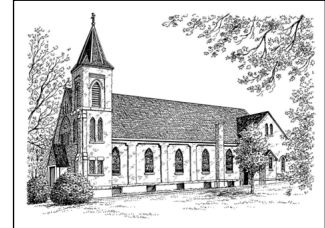

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

I hope you all are having a happy 4th of July weekend! As in the month of June, we have special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, so in the month of July we commemorate the Most Precious Blood of Christ.

This devotion is certainly not a new one in the Church, as it goes all the way back to the apostolic and patristic periods. This devotion allows us to further meditate and appreciate what God has done for us, and what is our true worth. Here are a few quotations upon which to meditate:

“Let us look steadfastly to the Blood of Christ, and see how precious that Blood is to God, which, having been shed for our salvation, has set the grace of repentance before the whole world.” -St. Clement of Rome [3rd or 4th pope], Epistle to the Corinthians 7

“As, then, when Egypt was smitten, the Jewish people could not escape except by the blood and the sign of the lamb, so also, when the world shall begin to be desolated and smitten, whoever is found in the Blood and the sign of Christ alone shall escape.” -St. Cyprian, Treatise 5, 22

“The anointing of truth is this; wherein the living and all-life-giving Blood, is sprinkled inwardly in your bodies, is mingled in your understandings, is infused through your inmost chambers.”
-St. Ephraim the Syrian, Hymn 3 for the Feast of Epiphany

Below is the Litany to the Most Precious Blood. Litanies are a beautiful way to more deeply meditate on the truth of some particular aspect of devotion. The italicized words are the responses to each invocation. For each invocation of the “Blood of Christ,” the response is “Save us.” This litany can easily be found online if you want it for later use.

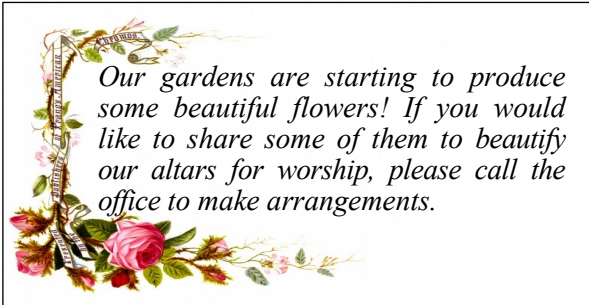

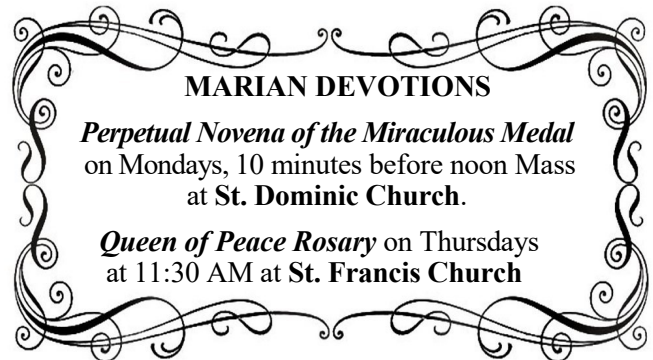
