Mission Appeal

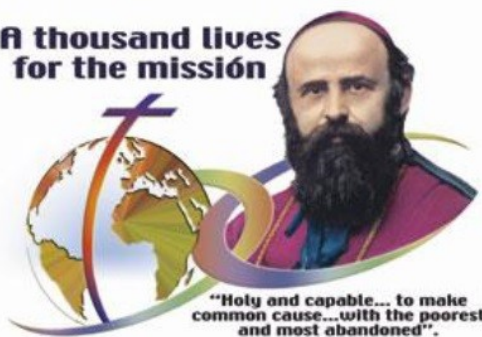
Next weekend, July 25 & 26, our Parish will participate in the Mission appeal initiative organized by the Missionary Cooperative Plan of our Diocese.

Since January, members of our parish have been meeting and working to organize our festival. It takes many hands from all corners of our parish to bring events such as this to a successful completion.

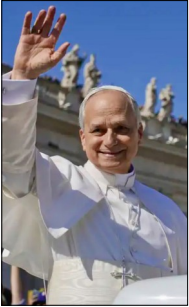
