

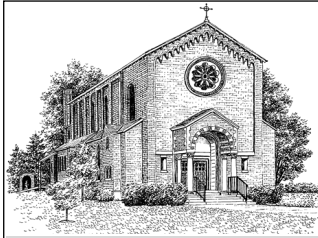

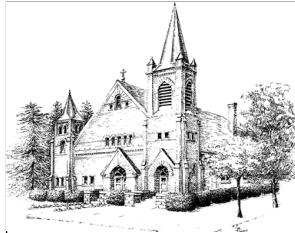

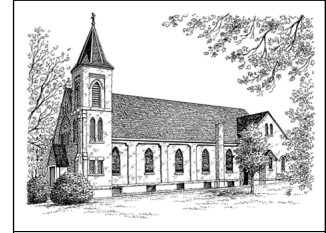

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

We are incredibly blessed to have a former bishop of our diocese, Fulton Sheen, being beatified on September 24 in St. Louis, Missouri! During the middle of the 20th century, Sheen was one of the most popular voices on radio and television, teaching the Catholic Faith with his amazing intellect and large personality. He served as the Sixth Bishop of Rochester from 1966 until 1969. By that time, he was already known all over the world for his *Life is Worth Living* show, episodes of which still hold their value, and often have proven to be a prophetic witness all these years later. Personally, I have watched on YouTube many hours of his show and other addresses he has given, to great benefit, throughout my time in seminary to this day.

As of right now, Fulton Sheen has the title of “Venerable.” This means that after a thorough examination of his life, speeches, and writings, he has been found to live a life of “heroic virtue,” and so given such a title. The next step was to determine if miracles can be attributed to his intercession, thereby giving us certainty that he is in heaven amongst the saints. “The alleged miracle involved the restoration of a stillborn child, James Fulton Engstrom, after 61 minutes without heartbeat or respiration.” ... “The miracle attributed to Sheen has been unanimously approved by doctors, theologians, and cardinals in the Congregation of the Causes of Saints and was officially recognized by the Holy Father, Pope Francis, on July 6, 2019” (<https://www.celebratesheen.com/cause>).

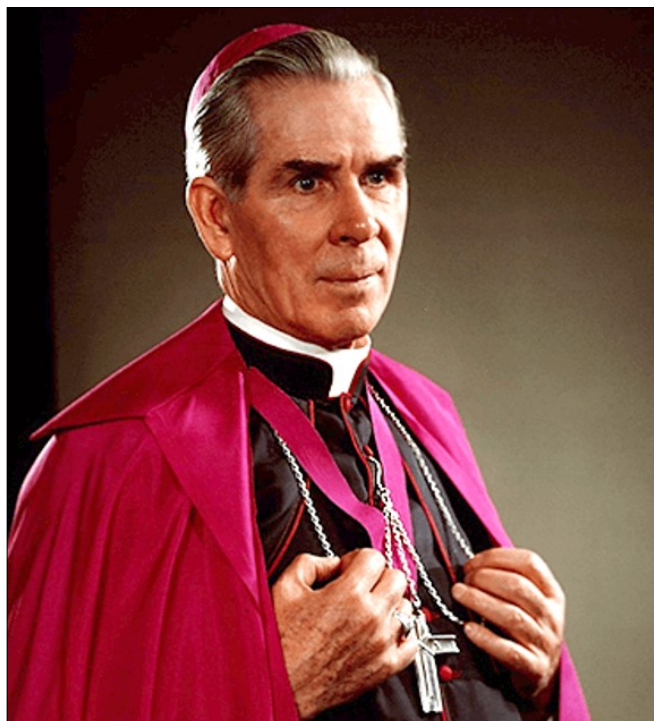
As for the celebration in our diocese, Bishop Bonnici is inviting everyone to a Mass at **Sacred Heart Cathedral on Tuesday, September 29, 2026, at 7:00pm**, where the diocese will receive a “substantial” first-class relic of Fulton Sheen as he will, by then, be given the title of *Blessed* Fulton Sheen.

Further, each deanery of our diocese will hold a special Mass with our bishop where the relic of Sheen will be brought to that church. For our deanery, the Mass will be held at **St. Stephen Church, Thursday, October 1, 2026, at 7:00pm**. I plan to be at both of those events!

This will be a beautiful celebration for our whole diocese. Please, also, pray for vocations to the priesthood. Our bishop, echoing a letter from Bishop Fulton Sheen to the faithful of our diocese, reminds us:

“Vocations are dwindling. We leave to others to seek out the causes of the decline. What is important is not to analyze chemistry of the waters which flood the sinking ship of vocations, but to refloat it. Today a thousand devices are used to instill vocations, such as deluging our youths with letters, pamphlets and appeals. But Our Lord gave only one way – and that way was prayer. [...] It may be a little disappointing to us that the solution to the problem of vocations is so simple, when we thought it was public relations, pictures of novices playing tennis and smiling like Hollywood teenagers. We have been inclined to follow every human resource before we come to what seems to be that ‘unpractical one of prayer.’ We are not face to face with a decline of vocations, but rather with a decrease in prayer. This is where we must begin.” (Bishop Fulton Sheen, April 4, 1967)
