

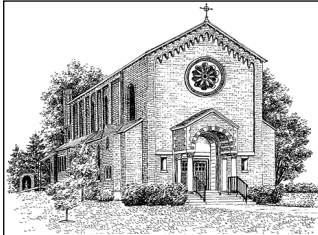

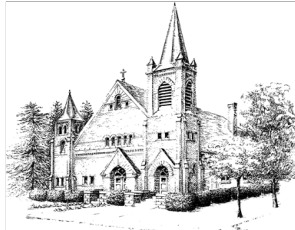

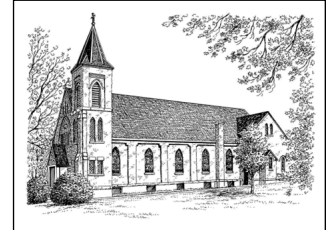

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

On August 4, the feast day of St. Jean Vianney, we were proud to host the annual Seminarian Picnic. I believe this was the 10th year of this event and the 6th at St. Dominic. It is an event sponsored by the St. Thomas Aquinas Homeschoolers of the Rochester Area (STAHRA), which has many families in the diocese involved. As always, it was another successful event with our newest priest, Fr. David Cataline, as the celebrant for the Mass and most of our seminarians present and serving the Mass.

This event started, and continues, so that people have an opportunity to meet the seminarians. For most people, they may just be faces on a poster for whom we pray. It is important for us to meet them, but also very important for them to meet everyone else. In my brief opening talk before I blessed the food, I mentioned to them how important it is to keep the faces of all these people in their minds as they go back to seminary. When difficulties and doubts arise during our formation, we have to see the faces of all those who are praying for us and supporting us. The people love their seminarians, and I was happy to host this event again so that these men are made aware of that!

We are blessed to have so many seminarians again. Please continue to pray for vocations and for the perseverance of our seminarians throughout their formation and their priesthood.

As always, the Knights of Columbus at our parish did so much to make this event run smoothly and successfully. Thank you to all of them, and to Deacon Dermot and Janene Loughran for making this event happen yet again.

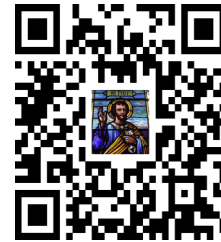

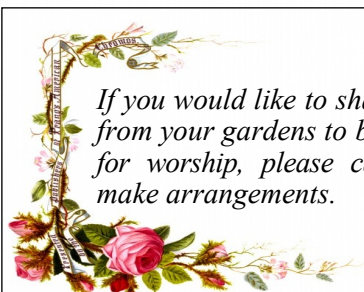
