



#### FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO



Two weeks ago I wrote briefly on the idea of *Millenarism*. This is the idea that there will be a thousand year reign of Christ prior to the Resurrection and Final Judgment at the end of time. I wrote that this view must be rejected for a few reasons, but mostly because it is not found in Scripture and not supported by the teaching of the Church and of the Fathers throughout history.

This week I want to briefly summarize what we believe will happen *after* the Judgment, that is, the end of the material world. The timing of this can be an open question as some theologians think the end of the material world will happen *before* the Final Judgment. Nevertheless, the Second Letter of St. Peter 3:7-12 gives us a glimpse of what will happen:

The present heavens and earth have been reserved by the same word for fire, kept for the day of judgment and of destruction of the godless. But do not ignore this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years and a thousand years like one day. The Lord does not delay his promise, as some regard "delay," but he is patient with you, not wishing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a mighty roar and the elements will be dissolved by fire, and the earth and everything done on it will be found out. Since everything is to be dissolved in this way, what sort of persons ought you to be, conducting yourselves in holiness and devotion, waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved in flames and the elements melted by fire. But according to his promise we await new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

As the bodies of the just will be renewed and glorified, so will all material creation. Recall how the original creation was a harmonious paradise with Adam and Eve prior to their sin. Once they sinned, creation was disfigured and it became so depraved that God destroyed the world in the Flood. Just as the world was disfigured by our sins, so it will be renewed and glorified with us. This will not happen again through a flood, but by fire.

Since our bodies will be glorified, we will be able to live in a home that is suitable to a glorified body. This is where we fought the battle of the Christian life, cultivated virtues, and even many suffered martyrdom. It is only fitting that all material creation, even inanimate creation, made through the Word of God, will be ordered towards Him: "When everything is subjected to him, then the Son himself will also be subjected to the one who subjected everything to him, so that God may be all in all" (1 Corinthians 15:28).

We have a unique place in the order of creation because of our likeness to God, and so we will have a unique place in the worship of God in heaven. But God's perfect goodness and love will shine forth, certainly in the souls of the just in a special way, but also throughout all creation for all eternity.


