

#### FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Last weekend we celebrated two of the most beautiful and moving feast days of the year: All Saints' and All Souls'. These days, in particular, bring together so much of what we believe about who God made us to be, our eternal destiny, and the care that we have for each other, even after death. If you were at the Saturday evening Mass for All Saints, you would have seen so many of our children dressed as saints for the occasion, in a grand procession to the sanctuary. This is not only a very tangible lesson for them as to who we are called to be, but a reminder for all of us as to what is happening at every Mass: we join with the saints and angels around God's altar to participate in the heavenly worship. We also need examples to follow, our older brothers and sisters in the Faith, to whom we look up, and from whom we seek help.

This weekend, we have yet another great feast day that supersedes the Sunday in Ordinary Time: Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. Understandably, most people think that St. Peter's Basilica is the "main church" of the Catholic Church. It is definitely the largest and where most large functions are held. However,

the Lateran Basilica is actually the seat of the Bishop of Rome, as that basilica is referred to as "the Mother and Head of all Churches in the City and the World."
