

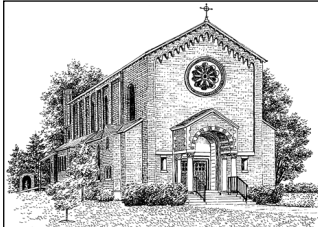

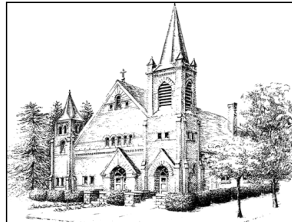

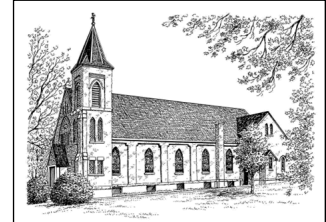

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

I wanted to continue elaborating on the Last Things, this time, regarding the resurrection of the body at the end. With these topics, since we have no direct experience of them (yet), of end of the world and the resurrection of the body, we rely on the testimony of Scripture, of the Fathers, and of the whole Tradition to discern such things.

One of the most fascinating aspects of the resurrection of the body is that the body will be made *out of the same matter as the body had before death*. How can this be? Throughout our life our bodies grow and change entirely over the course of many years. Out of the wisdom and omnipotence of God, matter will be used only as is required to form a perfect body. If all the matter that was ever part of our body in life would be used at the resurrection, we would be rather large. The definition of “perfect body” is not one bound by any societal standards, but one understood by philosophy and theology.

Part of the idea of the perfect resurrected body is that it is perfectly conformed to the soul and its operations. So, it is important that we understand the qualities (or dowries) of the resurrected body. The body will be given *immortality* as the soul already possesses by its nature. The first dowry is *impassibility*. This means that the body will no longer suffer in any way. It will not be corrupted or face any struggle with the passions and emotions. It will, however, have perfectly ordered passions that may go along with the sensing of objects.

Clarity is another dowry, or quality of the resurrected body. The *Roman Catechism* describes it as the quality “with which the bodies of the saints will shine like the sun. ...But this clarity is a certain brightness flowing into the body from the supreme happiness of the soul, so that it is a certain communication of the beatitude that the soul enjoys, just as the soul itself is rendered happy by a participation in the happiness of God.”

Agility is the quality that allows even our body to move as the soul would by itself. We can even say that we will be able to move in the same way the angels move from one place to another. St. Augustine tells us: “For we must believe that we will have such bodies that we will be where we want to be and when we want to go there” (Sermon 242). In other words, the body will be able to move from a place to any other place at the speed of mere thought.

Finally, the quality of *subtlety* can be seen in the previous qualities, but *subtlety* relates to the total subjection of the body “to the dominion of the soul, so that the body shall be subject to the soul and ever ready to follow her desires” (*Roman Catechism* 1, 12, 13). More specifically, it is the “spiritualization” of the body such that the body will be able to enter a place and pass through other matter without any damage to itself. Think about how, after the Resurrection of Christ, He was able to appear and disappear, to show up in a room with a locked door, while yet having a physical body that can be touched.

These topics are always good to contemplate as they allow us to long for the glorious resurrection that awaits us!

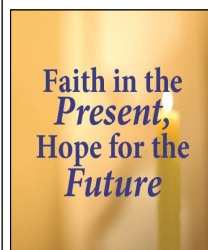
