

#### FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As we now enter the Advent Season, and a new liturgical year, we prepare ourselves again for the coming of the Messiah. The readings tend to have a dual focus: the coming of the Messiah into the world for the first time, in fulfillment of the prophecies, and then the Second Coming at the end of time, in judgment. These points are always held in tension. It is important to celebrate this season rather than merely skipping over it to the celebration of Christmas. The music for the Advent Season, for example, is some of the most beautiful and theologically rich music we have, but it is sadly not as well known among people today.

Part of our tradition is the singing/chanting of the 'O Antiphons.' An antiphon is a verse or maybe even a couple sentences that "sets the stage" for a Psalm that is about to be sung, for example. In the Liturgy of the Hours (Divine Office) you will see an antiphon recited/chanted before and after each Psalm or before the Gospel Canticle. For Vespers (Evening Prayer), the Gospel Canticle is Mary's *Magnificat* from Luke 1:46-55, sung by Mary after she visits her cousin Elizabeth.

In the final seven days leading up to Christmas – called the Greater Feria of Advent – we have special antiphons that bring together the various scriptural titles for our Lord based on the prophecies. These antiphons are called the 'O Antiphons' because each one addresses our Lord under these specific titles. They may date back all the way to the sixth century in Italy. You will recognize the antiphons because they make up the hymn "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel." For the next couple weeks, I will give you the antiphons showing the scriptural references associated with them.

**December 17: O Wisdom**, coming out of the mouth of the Most High, reaching from one end to the other, mightily and sweetly ordering all things: Come to teach us the way of prudence.

O Sapientia, quae ex ore Altissimi prodiisti, attingens a fine usque ad finem, fortiter suaviterque disponens omnia: veni ad docendum nos viam prudentiae.

Here we can see three passages (from the Douay-Rheims translation) that makeup this antiphon. I will put the relevant parts in italics.

Isaiah 40:14: With whom hath he consulted, and who hath instructed him, and taught him the path of justice, and taught him knowledge, and shewed him *the way of understanding [prudence]*?

Sirach 24:5: *I came out of the mouth of the Most High*, the firstborn before all creatures.

Wisdom 8:1: *She reacheth therefore from end to end mightily, and ordereth all things sweetly.* 

**December 18: O Adonai**, and leader of the House of Israel, who appeared to Moses in a flame of fire in a bush and gave him the law on Sinai: Come and redeem us with an outstretched arm.

O Adonai, et Dux domus Israel, qui Moysi in igne flammae rubi apparuisti, et ei in Sina legem dedisti: veni ad redimendum nos in brachio extento.

Here, there are quite a few references, but I will just give four:

Exodus 6:2-3: And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: I am the Lord, that appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, by the name of God Almighty; and *my name Adonai* I did not shew them.

Jeremiah 30:21: And their *leader* [dux] shall be of themselves: and their prince shall come forth from the midst of them: and I will bring him near, and he shall come to me...

Jeremiah 32:21: And hast brought forth thy people Israel, out of the land of Egypt with signs, and with wonders, and with a strong hand, and *a stretched out arm*, and with great terror.

Acts 7:30: And when forty years were expired, there *appeared* to him in the desert of mount Sinai, an angel *in a flame of fire in a bush*.

This may seem complicated, but it is important to see how the antiphons take many passages from Scripture and combine them into a synthesis that is then used to sing to God. I hope this Advent Season is a peaceful one, filled with the expectation of the coming of God into the world at Christmas.




