## FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Greetings from Juneau, Alaska! As I write this, I am on my last full day of retreat at the National Shrine of St. Thérèse, here on the coast of this beautiful state. I have not travelled the country that much, but I have never seen a place of such wonder and beauty. Besides the natural landscape, the Shrine's property is a place of peace. Anyone who comes here seems to think that God is here and He speaks. I have certainly been praying for all of you back home, and I do look forward to my return. This place, however, will always hold a place in my heart.

One thing I have reflected on from being here and reading about the priests who came to evangelize the people of Alaska, is how the priesthood is lived in various circumstances. The monastic life is one that is hidden, quiet, in prayer. It is marked by stability where men and women live and die in that place, their life given as a sacrifice to God. The secular life (diocesan priests) is what most of you are familiar with. We have direct care for the souls entrusted to us by the bishop, and care for all needs of the parish community. While I have read about the great missionary saints, I have not quite encountered a land like Alaska. In reading about what these priests endured to live amongst the people of Alaska and to serve them, I had that missionary zeal awaken a bit inside of me. In my own spiritual life, I tend towards the monastic aspect of the priesthood. But it was good for me to reflect and develop, in prayer, that missionary aspect of the priesthood which is needed so much today, not just in far off lands, but everywhere.
