God of all grace, Father of mercies, hope of Israel, Savior in time of trouble, why have you revealed yourself in such lovely characters and endearing relations if not to meet our despair, to remove our fears, and to induce us to say, "It is good for me to draw near to God" [Ps. 73:28]?
