# A Word From the Pastor

## The Impassibility of God

At different moments throughout Scripture, the biblical authors will refer to an emotion that God possesses. In Zephaniah 3:17, it is said that God “rejoices” and “shouts for joy.” In Deuteronomy 9:22, the Israelites are told that they “provoked the Lord to wrath.” Isaiah tells us that when God’s people were afflicted, He was afflicted as well (Isaiah 63:9). For many people, this poses a problem. How could God, who is unchangeable, feel emotion? If He is angry at one moment, and loving at the next, does that not signal that He changed? The answer to these objections lies in the doctrine called the impassibility of God.

The impassibility of God distinguishes His emotions from human emotions. This doctrine argues that God is not incapable of feeling emotion. However, emotions do not come over Him. Instead, they come from Him. This is not always the case for human beings. There are times when we are cognitively aware of our emotions. However, there are other times when they seem to appear and even surprise us. I am not known to be a person that cries during movies. However, Emily and I recently watched a movie that nearly brought me to tears. Saying that I was surprised by that emotion would be the understatement of the year! God does not experience emotions in this way. There is no emotion that has ever been forced upon God or one that surprised Him. Therefore, the fact that God feels different emotions does not mean that He changes. Instead, His emotions are perfectly fitting in every given situation.

How does this relate to our walk with the Lord? It reminds His people that we should align our emotions with His. Since His emotions are perfect, we know how we should think and feel about various situations that arise through the course of life. We do not have to wonder whether God hates murder or not. We do not have to guess whether God delights in our obedience or not. Even though we cannot perfectly do so on this side of eternity, we should strive to not be controlled by our emotions. Instead, we should seek to align our emotions with the perfect and righteous emotions of our Savior.
