A Word From the Pastor

“The Lord’s Supper”

This morning, we will be observing the Lord’s Supper at the conclusion of our worship service. Whether you have seen and participated in it for decades or it is a part of church that you are new to, it is important to periodically reflect on what the Lord’s Supper is. Over the next 3-4 Sundays, we will explore various aspects of this sacred task, beginning with 3 core functions.

First, when we observe the Lord’s Supper, we are participating in an act of worship. In 1 Corinthians 11, Paul instructs the church to “Do this in remembrance of me.” These words demonstrate that Communion is not primarily horizontal in nature. Instead, we are turning our attention toward the Lord, remembering and offering thanks for His redeeming work in our lives. Secondly, the Lord’s Supper is an act of evangelism. In verse 26 of that same passage, Paul says, “For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until He comes.” In other words, Communion is a picture of Christ’s sacrifice. Therefore, when an unbeliever witnesses the church partaking in the elements, they are beholding the gospel message. Lastly, the Lord’s Supper is an act of sanctification. Sanctification is the growth and maturity of a Christian over time. Just as an unbeliever, believers witness the message of the gospel when they partake in Communion. In a few weeks, I will dive deeper into this idea. For today, though, we should recognize that coming regularly to the Lord’s table renews our love for Christ and encourages us to die to our sin.

Today, as you come to the Lord’s Table, remember that you are not simply drinking some juice and eating a wafer of bread. In those few moments, you will worship the Lord. You will proclaim the message of the gospel. And you will be encouraged to grow in your walk with the Lord. Let us approach His Table humbly and expectantly.
