



# A Word From the Pastor

## "The Lord's Supper- Part 3"

In the last few articles, we have engaged in a brief study of the Lord's Supper. We have seen that the Bible presents the Lord's Supper as an act of worship, evangelism, and the believer's sanctification. The book of Acts also reveals that the early church observed communion often, possibly at each week's gathering. While those passages are enough to encourage the church to observe communion often, this morning I would like to explore another reason why God's people should observe communion often and consistently.

Throughout the Old Testament, God gave His people routines which their lives were organized around. The first routine that comes to mind is the observance of the Sabbath, which is rooted in God's rest after the six days of creation (Exodus 20:8-11). Another routine that is found in the Old Testament is the annual Day of Atonement. Each year, the high priest would enter the Most Holy Place in order to offer sacrifice for the atonement of sins. In addition to the Day of Atonement, God gave Israel many feasts to observe each year, including Passover, Booths, Unleavened Bread, and others.

When we arrive in the New Testament, God-given routines do not cease to exist. The first that comes to mind is the weekly observance of The Lord's Day (Acts 20:7, 1 Corinthians 16:2). Singing Psalms and Hymns would have been a routine included in the observance of The Lord's Day (Ephesian 5:2, Colossians 3:16). Reading, preaching, and teaching the Word of God is also a foundational routine given to the church (1 Timothy 4:13, 1 Peter 2:2). Finally, as I'm sure you have guessed by now, The Lord's Supper is also a routine that has been given to God's people (Acts 20:7, 1 Corinthians 11:23-26).

Why has God given these routines to His people? Routines are a part of everyone's life, and we are shaped by them. Routines influence the way think and the things we love. There are certainly other aspects of life that shape us. In part, genetics shape us. What you read and learn will shape you. Your family and culture have an influence on shaping you. Routines, though, are powerful shapers. Like a fish in water, we might not know that we are being shaped and formed by our routines, but we are. Therefore, God gives His people routines to shape us into the people He has called us to be. Coming regularly and often to the Lord's Table will shape our lives around the gospel because we will be regularly reminded of the Lord's death and resurrection. Pray along with me that the Lord would use His ministry to make us gospel people!
