A Word From the Pastor

"Introduction to Jonah"

This morning, we begin our journey through one of the most well-known books in the Old Testament. Jonah is located in a series of twelve books called the "Minor Prophets." These books were mostly written about God's people during a difficult time in their history. Some were written before Israel's exile to Babylon. Others were written afterward as God's people found their way back to the promised land. At first glance, it seems as though Jonah is not written about God's people at all. However, as we work our way through it, we will uncover profound insights for God's people, especially concerning our call to make disciples of the nations. Below, I will provide a few key principles that will guide our study.

First, we must remember that prophets do just as much "forthtelling" as they do foretelling. In other words, the prophetic books not only predict future events, but speak to God's people about a particular issue that they were facing. While there is some foreshadowing that occurs throughout this book, it is not Jonah's primary purpose.

Secondly, we must guard against falling into moralism. Each week, it would be easy to walk away from the text thinking, "Don't be like Jonah" or "Repent like Nineveh." Certainly, these are legitimate application points. However, no person other than God is the main character of Scripture. Therefore, each week, we will seek to highlight at least one characteristic or attribute of God that is found in the text.

Lastly, we will pay particular attention to location and repetition throughout the book. Throughout Scripture, many authors will utilize geography to emphasize theological points, which will be clearly seen in our passage this morning. Authors, especially of Old Testament books, also employ repetition of language to make their point clear. Both of these strategies are found throughout this beautiful book, and we will endeavor to learn from them.

Brothers and sisters, I am looking forward to studying this book with you. As we open God's Word to this ancient story, pray that the Holy Spirit illumine truths that you have not been shown before. Pray also that He will remind you of truths that you have known for years. Press on, church family!
