A Word From the Pastor

“SBC Summary: Part 2”

Last week, I provided a few of the most significant details that were reported by the IMB and NAMB at this year's Southern Baptist Convention. Another set of reports that are worthy of attention are those given by the SBC Seminaries. Below, you will find highlights from their reports as well as a few of my observations concerning those figures.

First, each seminary reported that enrollment is either on the rise or steady when compared to the past 4-6 years. While there was a small dip across the board for the year proceeding the COVID-19 pandemic, it has not shown to be a long-term trend. This was a positive report to hear, church family! There was a time in the SBC when it was quite uncertain whether our seminaries would remain afloat. However, by the grace of God, this is currently not a concern. These enrollment numbers indicate that in the next 5-10 years, and prayerfully beyond, churches within the SBC will have a well-stocked pool of seminary candidates to call into the pastorate. Again, praise the Lord!

Secondly, Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary (SEBTS), which is located in Wake Forest, NC, reported that Dr. Scott Pace will be the seminary's new president beginning in August of this year. Dr. Danny Akin has served as the president of SEBTS since 2004. It was a joy to witness the resounding applause that Dr. Akin received at his last convention before retiring. It was also a joy to see the presidency passed along to a faithful scholar who has a heart for the church, pastors, and missions. While I did not attend SEBTS, I am grateful for the scholarship of this institution. Please join me in praying for Dr. Akin in his retirement as well as Dr. Pace as he assumes this great responsibility.

Lastly, I would like to offer a note of personal appreciation. I am so thankful for a church that has supported and continues to support me through my educational endeavors. The SBC seminaries have a rich theological history and continue to provide faithful training for those called to the pastorate. However, these institutions would not exist without the churches of the SBC. So, thank you, church family!
