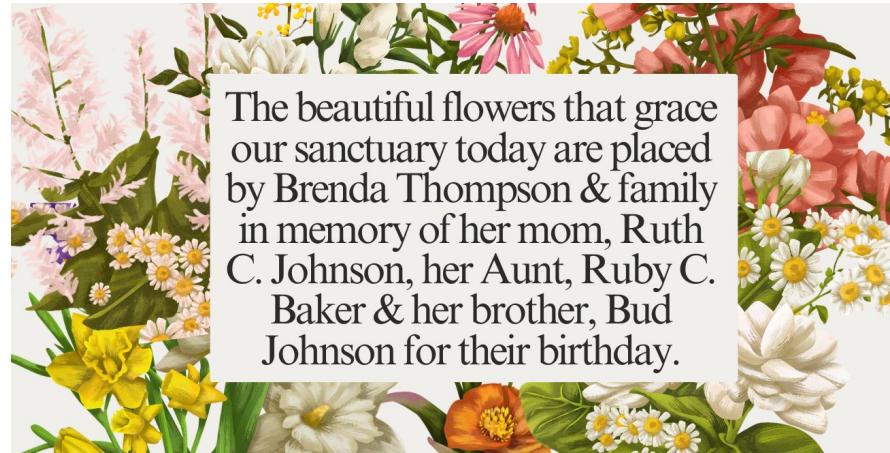

A Word From the Pastor

"The Beauty of God"

Over the past couple of months (minus a few weeks), we have explored various attributes of God in these articles. Together, we have learned about God's holiness, love, wisdom, and several other attributes. This week's article's focus is one of my favorite attributes to meditate upon: the beauty of God. In Psalm 24:7, the writer expresses a desire to "behold the beauty of the Lord." What exactly does it mean, though, for the Lord to be beautiful?

While on a youth mission trip to Maine a few years ago, I noticed that one of the adults from Maine had taken a step back from the work we were doing in order to observe what was taking place. As she stood there, her smile grew brighter and brighter. After a few moments passed by, she exclaimed, "This is just beautiful! I've never seen a group of young people work together so diligently for the Lord!"

The reason I share this story is that she employed the word "beautiful" quite similarly to the way we apply it to God. When she said, "This is just beautiful," she wasn't referring to our appearance. Instead, she was referring to a qualitative beauty. She was asserting that the youths' work ethic, cohesiveness, and passion were beautiful qualities. God's beauty is also qualitative in nature.

Speaking about the beauty of God, one theologian says, "God's beauty is that attribute of God whereby he is the sum of all desirable qualities." This is why He is the standard in all things. This is why we look to Jesus as our perfect example. And it is the reason the Psalmist desires to "behold the beauty of the Lord." My prayer this week has been just that, that I would look upon the beauty of God with amazement and seek to demonstrate His beauty by living out His qualities. As I have prayed to this end, I was reminded of one of my favorite hymns: "Fairest Lord Jesus." Perhaps I can persuade you to give it a listen this week as you behold God in all of His beauty?
