A Word From the Pastor

"SBC 2026"

This week, my family and I will travel to Orlando as I attend the Southern Baptist Convention's annual meeting as a "messenger" of FBC Manning. A "messenger" is a member of any church in the SBC that is sent to vote on any issues that are raised at that year's meeting. A few months ago, I raised this matter with our Deacons and they approved to send me as a 2026 messenger. For the most part, each year's meeting looks, feels, and sounds relatively similar. The business meeting portion of the convention spans two days and is accompanied by other meetings, conferences, and theological talks. A few weeks after the meeting, I plan to provide you all with a report of the highlights. Today, though, I want to give you a brief preview of what those days will entail for Southern Baptists.

First, the convention's messengers will meet this year to make decisions. Any major decision within the convention will take place during this gathering. For example, the leadership of the SBC, including the president, will be elected. These elections are significant as they will largely determine the direction of the SBC and its entities for the coming year. Also, at each year's meeting, various leaders, churches, and other messengers are allowed to make motions just as we do in our business meetings. Those motions are then discussed and receive a vote. This is the first major task of the messengers.

Secondly, the messengers have the privilege and responsibility of hearing reports from the entities of the SBC. For example, the president of each SBC seminary will give a report concerning the status of their seminary. Also, the president of the International Mission Board will provide a report. There are two primary purposes for these reports. The first is that they provide churches with an opportunity to hear about the gospel work that they are contributing toward. The second purpose is that they provide churches with transparency concerning the funds that they contribute to these entities.

Lastly, the messengers of the SBC have a unique opportunity each year to seek and showcase the unity we share in the gospel and the core doctrines of our faith. Of course, there are disagreements that arise from time to time. However, the SBC has historically been interested and capable of clarifying doctrinal stances and seeking unity where it is possible. I have no doubt that this will be the case next week. Please join me in praying for the decisions that we will make and for the reports we will hear. Above all, pray that God will be glorified through those actions and words.
