





A Word From the Pastor

“On Biblical Covenants”

Last week, we began a Lenten series that will focus on the covenants that God made with people throughout the Old Testament. Biblical covenants are “agreements or promises made between two parties (normally God and His people), which establish a relationship between them.” Last Sunday, we looked at the relationship that God established with Adam and Eve in the garden, as well as the covenant He established with them after the fall. Throughout the remainder of this series, we will give attention to the covenants made with Noah, Abraham, Israel, and David. Finally, we will ultimately turn our attention to the New Covenant which is established through the work of Jesus Christ. Below, I will provide a few reasons why I have chosen to explore this series.

First, this sermon series reflects the season of Lent. One function of the covenants of the Old Testament is that they anticipate the arrival and work of Jesus. During Lent, believers do not simply fast from food in order to lose weight. We don’t fast from social media in order to reset our neural pathways. We fast in order to draw closer to Christ as we anticipate the remembrance of His death and resurrection.

Secondly, the biblical covenants help us understand the whole story of the Bible. When I first began formal biblical studies, I found it difficult to understand many parts of the Old Testament. I found myself getting bogged down in books like *Numbers* and *Isaiah*. While I have not been wholly cured of this problem, understanding the “big picture” of the Bible has helped me greatly. Studying the covenants will serve as a foundation for grasping this “big picture.”

Lastly, the covenants remind us of God’s faithfulness throughout the ages. We live in a world that is full of broken promises. Even the most mature believers fall short of perfect faithfulness. However, over the coming weeks, we will be beautifully reminded that His faithfulness is perfect and complete. My prayer is that the Lord would use our time in His Word to draw us closer to Him and cause us to rely on Him.
