



A Word From the Pastor

"A Future Advent"

Last week marked the first week of Advent on the 2025 church calendar. The word "advent" refers to the coming of Christ into this world and being made in the likeness of men, as Paul says in Philippians 2. Throughout church history the season of advent has served not only as a time to reflect on Christ's first coming but also as a time to look forward to His second coming. Therefore, over the next few weeks, I would like us to dwell on the hope, peace, joy, and love that we anticipate in the Second coming of Christ.

Throughout Scripture, the word hope is not employed in the same way we use the word today. In modern English, "hope" is largely synonymous with the concept of a "wish." Again, though, this is not the case in Scripture. God's Word presents hope as a "Trustful expectation, particularly with reference to the fulfillment of God's promises. More specifically, hope is the confidence that what God has done for us in the past guarantees our participation in what God will do in the future." Hope is not a wish. It is not a dream. It is the anticipation of what is certain according to God's will.

In John 14:3, Jesus said, "I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also." This is not an isolated concept. God's Word is filled with promises about a future day when His people will live with Him in perfect relationship. This is the hope that Christians have concerning the future. Heaven is not a dream. The New Creation is not a fanciful wish. Life with Christ for eternity is a certain hope. So then, brothers and sisters, look forward to that day with great anticipation. Live today in light of your future hope in Christ.
