A Word From the Pastor

St. Augustine, one of the most significant theologians in church history, once said of The Gospel of John, “It is shallow enough for a child not to drown, yet deep enough for an elephant to swim.” What a beautiful statement! It is true, not just of the Gospel of John, but of the whole of God’s Word. God’s Word is accessible by all and so profound that even the most intelligent could never explore its depths in full.

This Wednesday, we will begin a series that I am calling, “How to read your Bible.” We will begin by exploring the nature of God’s Word, answering the question, “What is the Bible?” Following that introduction, we will study a few guiding principles for reading and understanding God’s book. Finally, we will discuss the proper application of God’s Word to our lives. In these sessions, we will regularly ask 3 questions. First, how does this apply to my life? Secondly, how does this apply to God’s church? And lastly, how does this apply to the world?

And so, this article is really an invitation. It is an invitation to join me in studying the practice of studying God’s Word. While I know that previous sentence was quite a mouthful, I want to encourage you that this series will not be a seminary lecture. We will not be sitting in our “ivory towers.” My goal is for this series to reflect what St. Augustine says of God’s Word, that it will be accessible to the newest Christian and edifying for even the most mature. Will you join me?
