

PLAY

Gather some small toy animals and hide them around the room.

Shepherds take care of sheep. If a sheep gets lost, it's the shepherd's job to find it. Can you help find the sheep? Search for the sheep until you find it. **You helped take care of the sheep by finding it. This reminds us of the story we are going to talk about, and how GOD CARES FOR US!**

BIBLE

Sit with your child and tell this story from Psalm 23. David writes a psalm describing how God is our Good Shepherd, the One who watches out for us and cares for us. God knows exactly what we need and when we need it, and He is our protector and comforter!
