Rockbridge Church is searching for a full-time and experienced pastor to serve as Pastor of Teaching and Spiritual Formation. This position has been developed and refined as part of a co-pastor team that will share authority equally. RbC has a strong emphasis in collaboration and humility and has determined a shared leadership model best serves our mission and vision in this season of our story. Both co-pastors serve in submission to one another and the Elders.

Joining our existing Pastor of Culture & Worship, the Pastor of Teaching and Spiritual Formation will primarily focus on casting vision, preaching, shepherding, and equipping our community.

The primary functions of the Senior Pastor of Teaching/ Spiritual Formation is to equip the saints for the work of the ministry through overseeing a thriving and dynamic teaching team, the teaching calendar, LifeGroups, men's and women's ministry, and the mission and outreach team. Along with the Senior Pastor of Culture/Worship, he oversees the development and implementation of a strategic plan enabling the vision of Rockbridge Church to be expressed. Both Senior Pastors serve on the board of elders.

- Perform weddings, funerals, and other non Sunday spiritual events as needed.
- Meet with congregants for shepherding/counseling when needed.

# Our Story

**THE NEED WAS CLEAR...** in September of 2014 a small group of friends and members of Orchard Hills Church in Roanoke, Va. began dreaming and praying over a new church community in Rockbridge County. This core-team was small but dedicated to the idea that every man, woman, and child in Rockbridge County deserve the opportunity to see, hear, and respond to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

**PERCEPTIONS WERE REAL...** many living in and around Lexington were convinced Jesus was irrelevant, His followers were inauthentic, and the Church seemed insignificant. This young core-team began the hard work of creating a space where these perceptions would be met with reality of the person of Christ. Jesus said "the thief comes to steal, kill, and destroy but I've come to bring life, and bring life to the full." It's this LIFE to the FULL that has captivated our hearts from the beginning.

**WORD GOT OUT...** our small team meeting in a living room quickly doubled, then tripled in size. Eventually, we moved to two Sunday evening gatherings and then to a local hotel conference room. As numbers grew, hearts and lives were changed as God continued to flesh out who RbC was called to become.

**DOORS OPENED...** on January 31st, 2016. RbC went public and began Sunday morning services at Maury River Middle School. Relational and authentic, full of humor and grace, with excellence and Christ-centered teaching, the church encouraged one another in discipleship and mission.

**WORK CONTINUES...** the mission is huge and the stakes are high. The RbC community continues to connect with others, serving for the sake of the Gospel, and becoming a force for transformation that brings LIFE to the FULL to Rockbridge County and beyond.

#### **OUR Beliefs**



#### THE BIBLE

We believe the entire Bible is the inspired Word of God. It is God's Word to all men. Human authors were moved by the Spirit of God to write the very words of Scripture, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. We believe the Bible is without error and our source of truth. (2 Timothy 3:16-17, 2 Peter 1:20-21, Proverbs 30:5)

#### **GOD**

God is the Creator and Ruler of the universe. He has eternally existed in three distinct persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal and are one God. (Genesis 1:1, Genesis 1:26-27, Psalm 90:2)

#### **MAN**

We believe that all people were created in the image of God to have a relationship with Him. Man became alienated in that relationship through disobedience towards God, which we call sin. As a result, we cannot gain a right relationship with God through our own efforts. We need Jesus. (Genesis 1:27, Romans 3:23, Isaiah 59:2)

#### **JESUS**

Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He is co-equal with the Father. Jesus lived a sinless human life and offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice for our sins by dying on a cross. He rose from the dead to show His power over sin and death. (Matthew 1:23, John 1:1-5, John 14:6, John 14:10, Titus 2:13)

#### **SALVATION**

Salvation means to be delivered from the power of sin. Jesus died a substitutionary death on the cross as payment for our sins. Only the blood of Jesus Christ, shed on the cross, provides the sole basis for the forgiveness of sin. God freely offers salvation to those who place their faith in the death and resurrection of Christ as sufficient payment for their sin. (Romans 6:23, Galatians 3:26)

#### THE CHRISTIAN LIFE

We believe all Christians (Christ-followers) should live for Christ and not for themselves. We do this by obeying God's Word and daily yielding to His Spirit. Every believer should mature, grow, and be conformed to the image of Christ. (Mark 12:30, John 14:15)

#### THE CHURCH

We believe that the church is the body of Christ, of which Jesus Christ is the head. The members of the church are those who have trusted, by faith, the work of Christ on the cross. The purpose of the church is to glorify God.

# FINANCIAL Health



By God's grace and provision, Rockbridge Church is in a healthy financial position. Our annual budget has grown from \$487,274 in 2019 to \$603,402 in 2024. RbC has met or exceeded its fiscal goals every year since the beginning. Our reserves beginning in the 2nd quarter of 2025 were \$377,987. Giving has increased by 47% from 2020 to 2025.


