I. Habakkuk background

- A. Ministered between 612 and 589 BC
- B. Main theme: God is still in control despite the apparent triumph of evil
- C. NOT a rebuke of a nation, but a dialogue between prophet and God
- D. About Babylon's rising and Judah's coming destruction

II. Big Questions! (Habakkuk 1:1-4)

- A. Habakkuk is the questioning prophet
- B. Habakkuk had questions about God TO God... WE ALL DO! (Habakkuk 1:2)
 - 1. Why is evil winning?
 - 2. How long Lord will you delay?
 - 3. Why is evil even allowed?
 - 4. WE get confused...GOD does not (Isaiah 55:8-9)

III. God Answers (Habakkuk 1:5-11)

- A. Look! Observe! Be astonished! Wonder! (Habakkuk 1:5)
- B. Here come the Chaldeans (Babylonians)
 - 1. Full of power, might, fury... (Habakkuk 1:6-10)
 - 2. Full of pride and idolatry

IV. Habakkuk's Response...(Habakkuk 1:12-17)

- 1. But God, they are the worst kind of evil, way more than us!
- 2. Will they just get away with it?
- A. Habakkuk gets in position to see and hear (Habakkuk 2:1)
 - 1. Keeping watch on the ramparts and guard posts (high ground)
 - 2. To see what he will speak...

V. God's Responds Again (Habakkuk 2:2-3)

- 1. Record the vision!
- 2. It hastens toward the goal and will not fail...WAIT for it.
- 3. Remember all He has done and the promises He's given
- A. The Righteous will live by Faith (Habakkuk 2:4)
 - 1. For salvation yes, but also everyday, in every situation
 - 2. Our questions don't scare Him, but lead us to Him, who He is and ultimately to trust.

VI. God's Judgement on Babylon (Habakkuk 2:5-19)

- A. God's Final Word (Habakkuk 2:20)
- B. But the Lord is in His Holy Temple, let all the earth be silent before Him!
 - 1. It's ok to say I don't like this, or I don't understand that
 - 2. But the Righteous live by faith...the Lord is on His throne!
 - 3. We seek, we listen, we wait, we trust!

VII. Habakkuk's Response (Chapter 3)

- A. Song of Praise
 - 1. Habakkuk praised his way out of anguish (Habakkuk:3-7, 13, 17-19)
 - 2. He will make our feet like "hinds feet"
 - Just like a small goat on a steep mountain side!
 - A small amount of faith will allow us to ascend to the high places!
 - 3. We wait, we trust, we worship!
 - 4. God is on His throne and worthy of ALL our praise
