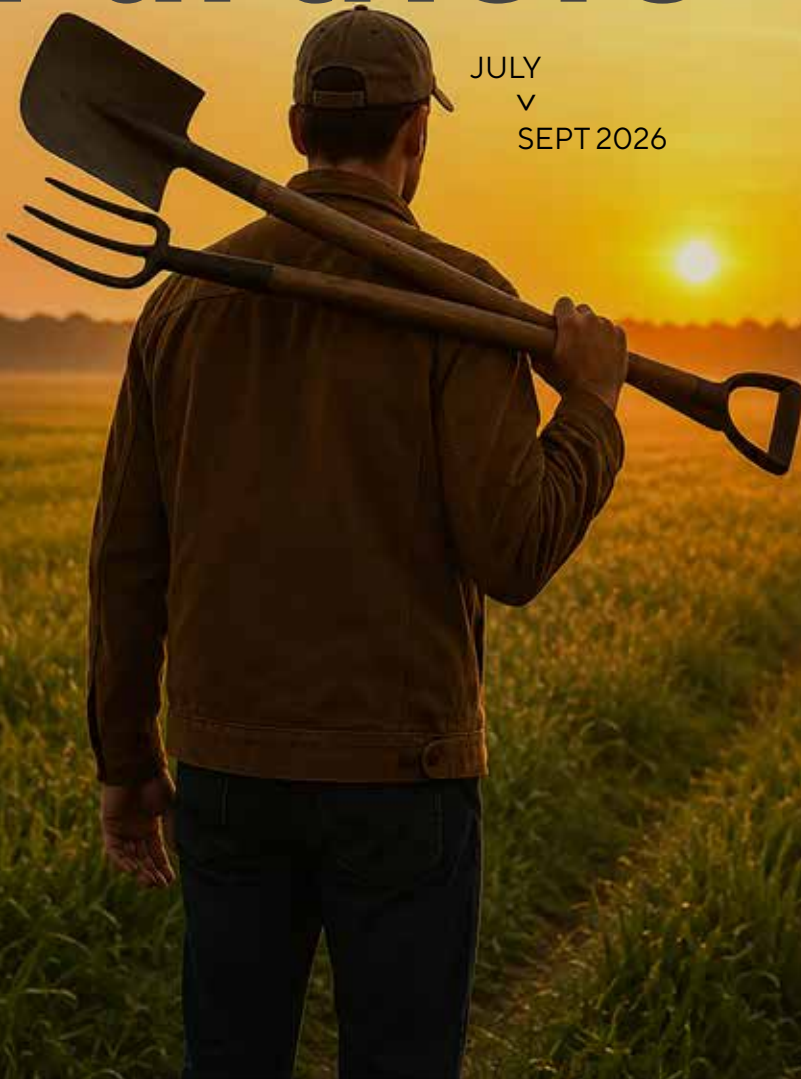

As you pray, be attentive to what God may place on your heart and how he may be calling you to respond.

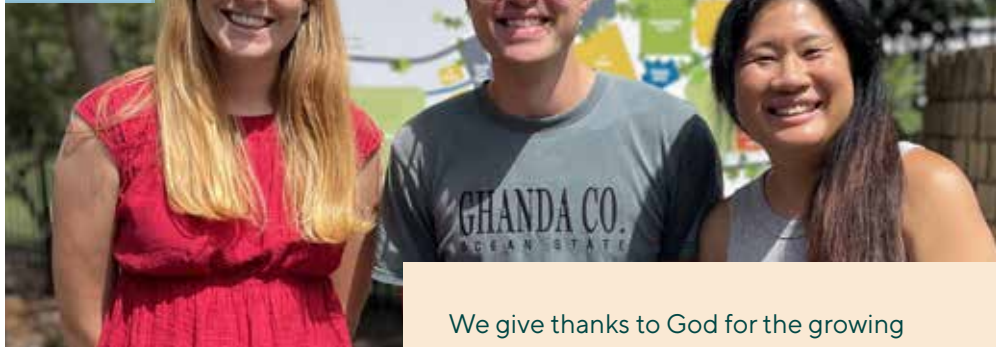
I would also welcome your feedback on how we can better communicate our Mission Partners' needs through this booklet, our bulletin, and our services.
