

Doodle Prayer Model

A simple and creative way to engage in prayer for those who find tangible and creative ways of being with God helpful. You'll need paper and some sort of writing instrument (colors, pencil, pen, markers, etc).

Write out your prayer – it doesn't have to be exhaustive or detailed, just names, snippets of circumstances, or simple references.

Doodle around the prayer – add color to words, underline, draw around it, create pictures, or any other way the Spirit moves through your creativity to help focus on the prayer.

Place your hand over each prayer and lift it to the Lord – ask for His presence and give yourself a moment of silence after each.

End – when you've had some time for each prayer, end the time with a simple 'Amen.'

Living Faith

The purpose of this prayer guide is to offer an on-ramp into talking with your Father in Heaven. It's not all that prayer can be, but it is a start. Even if all you have is 2 minutes, that's ok. But if the Holy Spirit draws you in, let Him lead as the conversation continues. On the back page, you'll find guidance to enrich your prayer journey further. Mon. Aug. 3	Trust in the Father - You are worthy of my devotion and trust, Father. Your faithfulness reaches to the skies.
Tue. Aug. 4	Trust in Jesus - Jesus, trustworthy and true, because of all you've done and who you are, my life belongs to you.
Wed. Aug. 5	Trust in the Spirit - Holy Spirit, the one whose presence turns me into a living temple, I abandon all I am to your guidance.
Thur. Aug. 6	Living Faith Acts - Father, may the people around me know my faith in you through the deeds I choose.
Fri. Aug. 7	Living Faith Obeys - Lord, I want nothing more than to live according to your perfect will. Show me what you want from me today.

Mon. Aug. 10	Living Faith Perseveres - When all seems lost, when hardships weigh me down, I will keep turning to you Lord.
Tue. Aug. 11	Living Faith Brings Joy - My greatest joy is you, Jesus. Regardless of my circumstances, I know I have everything because I have you.
Wed. Aug. 12	Living Faith Is Fixed on Jesus - Savior and king, may your presence, teachings, demeanor, and will be my only desire.
Thur. Aug. 13	Living Faith Gives Hope - There is nothing I can do, nothing anyone else can do, nothing that can get in the way of your love for me, Lord.
Fri. Aug. 14	Living Faith Offers Peace - When turmoil rises, when chaos roars, my peace is in you, Jesus...in you and your Spirit presence living in me.
Mon. Aug. 17	Living Faith Shines - Like a light shining in the darkness, your life in me shines for the world to see, Jesus.
Tue. Aug. 18	Living Faith Purifies - I confess my sins before you, Lord. I know that I am broken and in need of a savior. Purify this wayward soul.
Wed. Aug. 19	Living Faith Testifies - You are my only declaration, my only concern, my all in all, Jesus. If my life proclaims only you, I have lived well.
Thur. Aug. 20	Transformed Life - Lord, you love me just the way that I am. And you love me so much you promise not to leave me in this condition.
Fri. Aug. 21	Connected: God - Through faith I am saved, God. This is my heart’s cry, that I believe in and trust in you alone.

Mon. Aug. 24	Connected: Others - Thank you, Father, that you have provided the people in my life. Draw us ever closer to each other and to you.
Tue. Aug. 25	Investing Outward - It's too easy to live selfishly, Lord. Soften this heart of stone toward others, and show me how I might serve them.
Wed. Aug. 26	Glorifying God - From you, through you, and to you are all things, Lord. To God be the glory forever and ever.
Thur. Aug. 27	Transformational - Make the faith in my heart grow, God. May the testimony of my life be my tranformation from sinner to saint.
Fri. Aug. 28	Sacrificial - What would you have me lay down, Lord, so that another person might see the wonders of your mighty hand.
Mon. Aug. 31	Radical Reliance - I want you to be my all in all, Father. To turn to you alone in all my need. To trust you alone with my future.

There are many different ways to engage in prayer...contemplative, bold, out loud, silently, with a group, or solo. Through meditation, repetition, spontaneously, or through pre-written words. We can pray standing, sitting, lying down, or on a walk. There are models developed to help people pray well...the Lord’s Prayer is one of them. The next page is another. If it helps you to have some guidance for prayer, try the steps on the next page to guide you in talking with the Lord.
