Mission India - Please join us in praying for peace in Nepal. As protests continue, our partner there has asked for prayers "for our people, the leaders, and the peace of God and the change of heart."

Mission Aviation Fellowship/Chris & Debbie Klynstra in Paupau, Indonesia - Chris has been diagnosed with prostate cancer and is at intermediate risk, so the wait and see option is out. Though the doctor gave two options of radiation and surgery, surgery was strongly suggested in Chris' case. We have decided to go with surgery. Chris will have a PET scan on September 19th to make sure the cancer has not spread, and surgery is scheduled for October 9th. Please pray for a good recovery so they can return to Indonesia at the end of the year.

Elizabeth Edwards, Wound Nurse, Zimbabwe, Africa - We have been praying for a 15-year-old boy, Tafara, who sustained burns almost 2 years ago and still had many open painful wounds. Tafara had complicated surgery on August 25th at the Cure Hospital in Bulawayo, and he is doing well. He was taken back to the OR to regraft a few places which didn't take well, but he is in much less pain now that his wounds are covered! This was the last hope for this young boy, so continue to pray that he would experience complete healing.
