



# Worship Team Director (Volunteer Role)

**Purpose:** To ensure every worship gathering is **seamless, unified, and spiritually focused** by integrating music, production, and platform leadership, so nothing is missed and every cue is executed with excellence.

## Core Win:

**The room never feels disjointed.** Songs, transitions, Scripture moments, hosting, and sermon handoffs flow as one cohesive experience that leads people to Jesus.

## Primary Responsibilities:

### 1. Integrate the Entire Service Flow

- Own the **run sheet** for Sunday.
- Ensure the Worship, Production, Host, and Lead Pastor teams are aligned on the plan.
- Anticipate transitions and communicate timing clearly.
- Guard the “energy arc” of the service — maintain momentum and remove distractions.

### 2. Call Cues in Real Time

- Give clear direction to FOH tech, ProPresenter, lighting, and band.
- Ensure slides, lyrics, mics, and transitions fire **exactly when needed**.
- Signal starts, endings, builds, walk-ups, and walk-offs.
- Support the Worship Leader by handling logistics so they can focus on leading people.

### 3. Lead the Green Room / Pre-Service Briefing

- Gather worship + production + platform leaders 20–30 minutes before service.
- Review each segment of the flow.
- Clarify who is responsible for each cue.

### 4. Protect the Experience

- Solve problems quietly and quickly.
- Identify distractions and eliminate them before the room feels them.
- Ensure volunteers feel supported, not pressured.
- Keep communication calm, confident, and clear.

### 5. Carry the Culture of Way Church

- Model humility, joy, and a teachable spirit.
- Champion excellence — not perfectionism, but **intentionality**.
- Encourage teammates and create a safe place to grow.

## Time Commitment:

- One Sunday every 2–4 weeks
- 2 hours on Sunday (call time + service + post-service wrap-up)
- Occasional midweek coordination with Worship Lead and Production Lead

## Ideal Volunteer:

- Fast thinker, clear communicator
- Loves systems and order
- Calm under pressure
- Deeply values worship and spiritual formation
- Can see the “whole room” and think two steps ahead
- Collaborates well with musicians and tech teams

## How This Role Serves the Mission:

Way Church is built on environments where people can encounter Jesus without distraction. The Worship Team Director protects that environment by ensuring the worship gathering is **safe, smooth, Spirit-sensitive, and well-integrated** from first note to final benediction.
