# DEFINING MOMENTS

THE LORD'S BEEN GOOD TO ME

THE LORD'S BEEN GOOD TO ME

**September 12, 2010** – A small group of believers began gathering in a gym on Satellite Boulevard in Suwanee. These early meetings were centered on prayer, the preaching of God's Word verse-by-verse, and a shared vision for planting a faithful, gospel-centered church in the community.

**January 23, 2011** – Emmaus Church held its first official Sunday gathering. This milestone represented the transition from a small core group to an established congregation.

**January 2013** – The church relocated to the Mall of Georgia movie theater.

**November 2013** – Emmaus Church moved to its current location at 75 Maddox Road. This step created greater opportunities to follow Jesus, make disciples, and plant churches.

**October 2014** – The church sent its first official mission team to Uganda. This marked a significant step in our commitment to global missions and the Great Commission.

– Over the next decade, Emmaus Church took many more mission trips, deepening its partnership with ministry efforts in Uganda. In 2020, the Emmaus church family sacrificially gave and fully funded the construction of a school in Uganda in less than one month, demonstrating remarkable gospel generosity.

**2015–2025** – As Emmaus continued to grow, additional suites were added at the 75 Maddox Road location to support expanding ministries. Since 2018, the church has experienced an average of 15% year-over-year growth, reflecting God's ongoing work and faithfulness to Emmaus Church.

**September 2025** – Emmaus Church closed on the purchase of 30 acres of land at the corner of Thompson Mill Road and Ridge Road in Buford, Georgia. This milestone represents a significant step toward our church's future, as we have the opportunity to build a gospel-proclaiming, Jesus-exalting, Bible-preaching, disciple-making church for the next generation.



# Where We've Been



Emmaus Church began more than fifteen years ago with a small group of people who were passionate about Jesus and committed to Scripture, gathering first in a gym and later in a movie theater before eventually meeting where we are now. From the beginning our heart has been simple and biblical:

**follow Jesus, make disciples, and plant churches.**

Those early years were marked by humble spaces and wholehearted devotion as God continued to provide, shape, and grow a church family centered on the gospel. What began as a few believers seeking to know Christ and make Him known became the foundation of a community that has experienced God's faithfulness again and again.





# Where We Are



Today Emmaus Church is experiencing a season of remarkable growth as the Lord continues to move among His people. Our average weekly attendance has increased from six hundred in 2018 to more than nine hundred in 2025, with this past September averaging more than one thousand people each week and showing fifteen percent year-to-year growth. All of our ministries are also seeing significant growth, and the Lord is doing an incredible work in the *next generation* at Emmaus Church.

Through all of this, God has provided abundantly, including the incredible gift of purchasing land at the corner of Ridge Road and Thompson Mill Road in Buford, which now stands as a clear reminder of His faithfulness and His continued work in our church family.





# Where We're Headed





# Q&A

## Are my regular tithes and offerings part of my pledge for To Another Generation?

No, tithes and offerings fund ongoing ministry at Emmaus, and those needs will continue. We are asking the people of Emmaus to make a pledge for To Another Generation that will be above and beyond regular giving.

## How will giving toward pledges be structured?

The 3-year commitment is flexible. Giving can be spread evenly over each year, paid in installments or one-time annually, or it can vary from year to year to achieve the total pledge amount. Additionally, giving appreciated assets is an available option.

## How does asset giving work?

For many, giving assets (investments, real estate, etc.) can increase flexibility to give and create tax benefits. Emmaus can receive stock, mutual funds, cryptocurrency, and real estate, among other options. If you have questions about these avenues please let us know and we can provide more specific information based on your situation.

## When should I make my pledge?

A life of discipleship is meant to be a life lived in community. While giving decisions and amounts are personal, we believe there is value to our giving together. We will have a **Commitment Sunday on March 15th** and there will be early commitment opportunities for those who are prepared to make their pledge before that time. If the Lord is leading you to give, please do so — we don't want an arbitrary date to stand in the way of your obedience.
