


MARCH MINISTRY PARTNER SPOTLIGHTS

KYKD Radio: God has allowed KYKD to extend Christian radio in western Alaska. A station in Kotzebue is the latest of 11 transmitters operated from the KYKD facility in Bethel. Pray that God will use these stations to bring the Gospel to the spiritual darkness of this region. Also pray that He will provide additional volunteers. KYKD appreciates SBC's support as they seek to advance His Kingdom.

KICY Radio in Nome serves over 40 villages on the Western coast of Alaska and in Russia. They provide a connection to Gospel programming and locally relevant programming. When the people of western AK are sleeping, KICY turns its antennae to Russia, reaching approximately 1,000 miles into the Gospel-starved nation. They are currently looking for volunteers willing to commit to at least a year as KICY staff. No radio experience necessary.

Solid Rock Bible Camp: Bert & Donna Schultz' efforts and the help of volunteers laid the spiritual foundation for a camp & its people who are "built on the Solid Rock." Under the current leadership, SRBC serves as a vibrant outreach to hundreds of kids each year. The camp also serves the community through retreats & annual events. At SRBC, God's Word & the Gospel are taught & lives are eternally changed.
