

JULY MINISTRY PARTNERS

Ryan & Rebecca Stowell serve with CORD Ministries in Thailand. The Stowells minister at Seed of Hope, a Christian based dorm for children. Many Akha people live in poverty & have difficulty accessing education. These children are at higher risk of being sold into child labor, slavery, or prostitution. The goal of Seed of Hope is to lead students to a relationship with God through Jesus, to give them access to public & college education, & to develop sustainable practices through planting crops, raising animals, & creating business opportunities.

Ron & Kim Linegar serve in southeast Asia by training national ministry leaders in operation of a farm and ranch, for the purpose of providing an income for those in ministry. God has provided people who are seeking Biblical truth. The Linegars provide pastoral education, Bible studies, VBS, English classes, & outreach. They also train lay leaders, disciple nursing students, & raise teams to evangelize. Ron and Kim are working on transitioning to partial retirement.

Caleb & Candice (purposely omitting their last name): In SE Asia many people are unreached and live in gospel poverty, but Caleb and Candice believe God is at work! They work with a local school, volunteer at English Clubs, and are building partnerships with local churches and ministries as they develop relationships in their community to further the gospel. Caleb and Candace are currently back in the States raising support.

The July Sunday school offering is going to Teach Beyond to help Ann Marlowe (daughter of one of our supported missionaries) with her travel expenses to go to Indonesia to teach at a mission school.
